This link will be live starting December 1, 2016.

How it works

- 1. On the Challenge page enter your name and email, and choose your school from a drop-down menu
- 2. Complete the online Challenge
- 3. Receive your proof of participation
- 4. Schools with 100 participants earn 10 points. The school with the most points in each bracket earns 25 points.
- 5. Each student who completes the Challenge and brings in their proof of participation will earn 1 hour of community service credit

The school who has the most students complete the Challenge will earn 25 points at the end of the Challenge!

Distractology aims to create a new generation of safer drivers. To date, drivers who've completed Distractology are proven to be 19% less likely to have major/minor accidents and 25% less likely to get traffic violations.
