Al Sandbox: A User's Guide

What is the Sandbox?

- A protected and secure AWS account that is dedicated to piloting AI platforms, tools, and solutions. It is isolated from the other Executive Office AWS accounts that contain non-Prod and Production workloads.
- Starting with AWS and AWS focused technologies.
 Other technologies such as Microsoft Copilot and Google Gemini will be considered as we prove out the sandbox working model with the AWS AI Sandbox account.

Who is the sandbox for?

- Innovate MA (Northeastern & Commonwealth partnership)
 Northeastern students and faculty will be working together with CoMA staff to develop AI solutions to identified unique use cases. Starting from the business challenge with the goal of developing a solution that can be put into production.
- Executive Branch Individuals and teams from every Executive Branch are invited to explore AI with the goal to develop potential AI solutions that solve a business need and or have a positive citizen outcome.

Where to begin?

 Kickoff drop-in sessions.
- Al enablement with AWS –
 Education on the Al tools and services that AWS provides.

 Open to all Executive Branch and Northeastern Innovate MA participants.

Are there guardrails?

- EOTSS has issued Terms and Conditions for use of the sandbox. Example: No state sensitive data allowed.
- Open safe space with limited restrictions to encourage innovation.
- Limited set of controls to help protect each project's autonomy.
- Spend ceiling alerts to control costs.
