Penalties & Reimbursements

Administrative Penalties

The Division collected a total of \$35,500.00 in administrative penalties.

Consumer Reimbursements

The Division reimbursed \$1,726,266.68 to 18,322 affected consumers.

DOB News and Outreach

On July 26, 2024, the Division of Banks, the State Treasurer's Office of Economic Empowerment (OEE), and the Office of Consumer Affairs and Business Regulation (OCABR) announced the <u>recipients of the 2024 round of Operation Money Wise</u>. This grant funding promotes financial education programming for non-profit organizations, public agencies, and higher education institutions that serve the military community in Massachusetts.

On September 24, 2024, the Division of Banks in collaboration with the State Treasurer's Office of Economic Empowerment and the Office of Consumer Affairs and Business Regulation, announced funding for the 2025 Financial Education Innovation Fund Grant. Created in 2015, the Innovation Fund supports financial education fairs, known as Credit for Life, in schools across Massachusetts with the goal of increasing skills and knowledge in money management.
