## **CONSENT AGREEMENT**

The Board of Registration in Pharmacy ("Board") and Thomas R. Wilmot, R.Ph. ("Registrant"), a pharmacist registered by the Board (Pharmacist Registration No. 16772), do hereby stipulate and agree that the following information shall be entered into and become a permanent part of the file of the Registrant which is maintained by the Board:

- The parties enter into this Consent Agreement ("Agreement") in order to resolve that certain complaint pending against the Registrant as Docket No. 20080718PH013 (the "Complaint").
- 2. The Complaint alleged that on or about February through June of 2006, while employed at Apothecary Express in Concord, New Hampshire, the Registrant engaged in professional misconduct while employed as a pharmacist in the State of New Hampshire. The Registrant acknowledges that he entered into a Settlement Agreement (attached) dated June 17th, 2008 with the State of New Hampshire which included a Reprimand of his license to practice in that State.
- 3. Accordingly, the Registrant freely agrees to the following:
  - That the conduct described in Paragraph 2 above constitutes professional a. misconduct which warrants disciplinary action pursuant to G.L. c. 112, §§ 42A and 61 and 247 CMR 9.01(1);
  - Registrant's Massachusetts Pharmacist Registration is hereby REPRIMANDED b. by the Board for Registrant's conduct in this matter; and
  - c. The Registrant shall return a signed copy of this Agreement to the Board within ten (10) days of receipt.
- The Agreement and its contents shall become a part of the records maintained by the Board, and as such, is a public record subject to disclosure to the public, other licensing boards, and the National Association of Boards of Pharmacy.
- The Board agrees that in return for the Registrant's execution of this Agreement, the Board will not advance the prosecution of the Registrant pursuant to the Complaint; any and all other rights of the Board to take action within the scope of its authority are expressly reserved. DEC 30 2008

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- 6. The Registrant understands and agrees that his failure to abide by the terms of this Agreement shall nullify the representations contained in Paragraph 5 and permit the Board to initiate formal adjudicatory action under the State Administrative Procedure Act (G.L. c. 30A) and 801 CMR 1.00 *et. seq.*
- 7. The Registrant understands and agrees that his decision to enter into this Agreement and to accept the terms and conditions herein described is a final act and is not subject to reconsideration or judicial review.
- 8. The Registrant states that he has used legal counsel in connection with his decision to enter into this Agreement or, if he did not, that he had an opportunity to do so and that his decision to enter into this Agreement was made of his own free will.
- 9. Registrant certifies that he has read this document entitled "Consent Agreement." The Registrant understands that, by executing this Agreement, he is waiving his right to a formal hearing at which time he would possess the rights to confront and cross-examine witnesses, to call witnesses, to present evidence, to testify on his own behalf, to contest the allegations, to present oral argument, to appeal to the court in the event of an adverse ruling, and all other rights set forth in the State Administrative Procedure Act, G.L. c. 30A, and the Standard Adjudicatory Rules of Practice and Procedure, 801 CMR 1.01 et seq.
