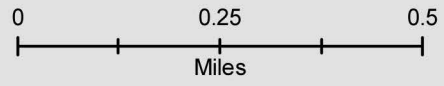


Beach Width Fronting Coastal Banks Duxbury Beach to Saquish Beach



- Beach width was defined as the distance between the 2001 high-water shoreline and the 15-foot elevation contour from 2000 NOAA LIDAR data.
- Length of bars illustrates relative magnitude of beach width.
- Unknown stretches are from areas where LIDAR data is unavailable.

White lines represent town boundaries and dashed black lines show littoral cell boundaries.
