CONSENT AGREEMENT FOR VOLUNTARY SURRENDER

The Massachusetts Board of Registration in Pharmacy (Board) and Tishana Postell (Licensee), a Pharmacy Technician Trainee (PTT) licensed by the Board, license number PTT101037, do hereby stipulate and agree that the following information shall be entered into and become a permanent part of the Licensee’s record maintained by the Board:

1. The Licensee acknowledges that the Board opened a complaint against their Massachusetts PTT license related to the conduct set forth in Paragraph 2, identified as Docket Number PHA-2024-0033 (the Complaint).¹

2. The Licensee and the Board agree to resolve this Complaint without making any admissions or findings and without proceeding to a formal adjudicatory hearing. The Complaint alleges the following:

The Licensee was identified by CVS #915 (DS3395) in Beverly, Massachusetts as the employee who pilfered #120 oxycodone 5mg tablets on or about December 1, 2023, in violation of Massachusetts General Law (MGL) Chapter 94C Section 37, which is grounds for discipline pursuant to Title 247 of the Code of Massachusetts Regulations (CMR) Section 10.03(1)(x).

3. The Board and Licensee acknowledge and agree that based upon the conduct described in Paragraph 2, the Board could find the Licensee in violation of MGL Chapter 94C Section 37, warranting disciplinary action by the Board pursuant to 247 CMR Section 10.03(1)(x).


4. The Licensee agrees to SURRENDER their PTT license for an indefinite period of time and refrain from practicing as a PTT and from working in any pharmacy-related setting in Massachusetts, commencing with the date on which the Board signs this Agreement (Effective Date).

¹ The term “license” includes a current license and the right to renew an expired license.

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5. The Licensee agrees that they will not practice as a PTT or work in a pharmacy related setting in Massachusetts from the Effective Date unless and until the Board reinstates their license.²
6. The Board agrees that in return for the Licensee's execution of this Agreement, it will not prosecute the Complaint.
7. The Licensee understands that they have a right to a formal adjudicatory hearing concerning the allegations against them and that during said adjudication they would possess the right to confront and cross-examine witnesses, to call witnesses, to present evidence, to testify on their own behalf, to contest the allegations, to present oral argument, to appeal to the courts, and all other rights as set forth in the Massachusetts Administrative Procedures Act, MGL c. 30A, and the Standard Adjudicatory Rules of Practice and Procedure, 801 CMR 1.01, *et seq.* The Licensee further understands that by executing this Agreement they are knowingly and voluntarily waiving their right to a formal adjudication of the Complaint.
8. The Licensee acknowledges that they have been at all times represented by Counsel or otherwise free to seek and use legal counsel in connection with the Complaint and this Agreement.
9. The Licensee acknowledges that after the Effective Date, the Agreement constitutes a public record of disciplinary action by the Board. The Board may forward a copy of this Agreement to other licensing boards, law enforcement entities, and other individuals or entities as required or permitted by law.
10. The Licensee certifies that they have read this Agreement. The Licensee understands and agrees that entering into this Agreement is a final act and not subject to reconsideration, appeal, or judicial review.

² The Licensee understands that practice as a licensed PTT includes, but is not limited to, seeking and/or accepting a paid or voluntary position as a licensed PTT, or a paid or voluntary position requiring that the applicant hold a current PTT license. The Licensee further understands that if they accept a voluntary or paid position as a PTT, or engages in any practice of pharmacy after the Effective Date and before the Board formally reinstates their license, evidence of such practice shall be grounds for the Board's referral of any such unlicensed practice to the appropriate law enforcement authorities for prosecution.
