
MAURICE J. TOBIN BRIDGE LONG-TERM STRATEGIC PLANNING STUDY

What is the Maurice J. Tobin Bridge Long-Term Strategic Planning Study?

The study aims to develop and analyze options for the eventual replacement of the Tobin Bridge. In addition to exploring alternatives for the Bridge, the study will focus on ways to reconnect surrounding communities in Chelsea and Charlestown.
