The first public information meeting for MassDOT's Tobin Bridge Long-Term Strategic Planning Study will take place in-person on Wednesday, November 20 from 6:30 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. with virtual attendance on Zoom. This study will develop and evaluate alternatives for the eventual replacement of the Tobin Bridge, connecting Chelsea and Charlestown.
