Patty Carlino moved to see if the Town will vote to rescind a vote taken under Article 19 of the Warrant for the February 8, 1932, Town Meeting, or any other acceptance of Civil Service status for employees of the Lee Police Department. Seconded by Tom Wickham. With no debate the motion passed unanimously.
