RECOMMENDED FINAL DECISION

Gerald Milden ("Petitioner") filed this appeal concerning the real property at North
Harbor Inlet, Chatham, Massachusetts ("the Property"). The Petitioner challenges the
Superseding Amended Order of Conditions ("SAOC") that the Department's Southeast Regional
Office issued to the Applicant, the Town of Chatham ("Chatham"). The Petitioner's appeal is
focused solely on the SAOC's approval of dredging at the North Harbor Inlet.

Chatham's Board of Selectman recently voted not to pursue the portion of the town's dredging permit approved in the SAOC which authorized dredging at the North Harbor Inlet.

Consequently, the Town filed a motion to dismiss this appeal for mootness. MassDEP assented to the motion. The Petitioner opposes the motion unless upon dismissal MassDEP's Commissioner issues a Final Amended Order of Conditions ("FAOC") that withdraws authorization for dredging at the North Harbor Inlet. MassDEP has filed with the Office of Appeals and Dispute Resolution ("OADR") a proposed FAOC that provides the relief requested by the Petitioner. The FAOC states: "The proposal to dredge the North Harbor Inlet (item 4 in the GEI 10/16/2018 Request to Amend Order of Conditions / DEP File #SE 10-2759 / CWP15-241N) has been withdrawn and is not authorized under this Final Order. Any future dredging

proposed in the North Harbor Inlet area will require the filing of a new Notice of Intent or

Request to Amend the current Order of Conditions." Issuance of the FAOC would leave no

issues to adjudicate in this appeal, rendering it moot. I therefore recommend that MassDEP's

Commissioner issue the proposed FAOC and a Final Decision dismissing this appeal as moot.
