FINAL DECISION

Martin Suuberg, the Commissioner of the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection ("MassDEP" or "the Department") has designated me as the Final Decision Maker in these consolidated appeals.

The Town of Falmouth ("Falmouth"), Petitioner in Docket No. 2021-004, and the Buzzards Bay Coalition, Inc. and 12 Individual Citizens (collectively, "BBC"), Petitioners in Docket No. 2021-005, challenged a Groundwater Discharge Permit ("GWD Permit") that the Southeast Regional Office of the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection ("MassDEP" or "the Department") issued to the Town of Falmouth on January 5, 2021. The GWDP Permit authorizes Falmouth to discharge into the ground a treated effluent from the wastewater treatment facility located at 154 Blacksmith Shop Road in Falmouth. MassDEP issued the Permit pursuant to the authority of M.G.L. c. 21, Sections 26-63, 314 CMR 2.00 and 314 CMR 5.00.

Falmouth's appeal challenged certain changes from its 2015 GWD Permit that it claimed

lacked justification, were unreasonably burdensome and created uncertainty. BBC's appeal

claimed that in issuing the GWD Permit, MassDEP failed to consider BBC's comments, failed to

follow or account for MassDEP's precedent in comparable circumstances, and failed to follow its

own regulations and state law.

On May 20, 2021, the parties jointly filed a stipulation of dismissal and agreed to dismiss

the appeals with prejudice. The parties agree that the GWD Permit, as issued by MassDEP, shall

become final. The parties' stipulation of dismissal of the appeals constitutes a waiver by the

parties to any further administrative review before the Department as well as appeal to court of

the GWD Permit that was at issue in these appeals. Accordingly, the Department issues this Final

Decision dismissing these appeals.
