## **DECISION**

SEASON'S PALACE #3, INC. DBA YEE'S VILLAGE 350 MAIN STREET TOWNSEND, MA 01469 LICENSE#: 128600014 HEARD: 11/29/2011

Season's Palace #3, Inc. dba Yee's Village (the "Licensee") holds an all alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, November 29, 2011, regarding an alleged violation of M.G.L. c.138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Brad Doyle's Compliance Check Field Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts; and

2. Compliance Check Field Report of Brad Doyle dated 08/01/2011.

## **FACTS**

1. On August 1, 2011 at approximately 7:52 p.m., Commission Investigators investigated the business operation Season's Palace #3, Inc. dba Yee's Village.

2. An underage operative, working with the investigators, purchased a Budweiser bottle for two dollars and seventy-five cents (\$2.75). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

3. The underage operative was eighteen (18) years old, with a date of birth of November 29, 1992.

4. Administrative review of the files indicates the licensee has had the license since 1990 with no prior violations.

## **CONCLUSION**

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated M.G.L. c.138, §34. As the licensee has been in business for ten (10) years and had no previous violations, the Commission issues a WARNING.
