**Background:** Pursuant to 5 U.S.C. 5707(b) the General Services Administration sets the

Federal travel reimbursement rates. The Trade Adjustment Assistance program regulation at 617.28(b) requires Trade eligible customers who are participating in

Travel regulations. The Federal rate increased from 0.565 cents per mile to

reimbursed for travel costs at an amount not to exceed the lesser of the actual cost of transportation by the least expensive means that is reasonably available or the cost per mile at the prevailing mileage rate authorized under the Federal

0.575 cents per mile effective January 1, 2015.

The Massachusetts Trade Adjustment Assistance program will reimburse Trade customers eligible for travel cost reimbursement at the new rate of 0.575 cents per mile for use of a privately owned vehicle. The announced change is effective as of January 1, 2015.
