Subject: Trade Adjustment Assistance Mileage Reimbursement Rate Change

Purpose: To notify Local Workforce Development Boards, One-Stop Career Center Operators

and other workforce partners of a change in the mileage reimbursement rate for

Trade Program customers.

Background: Pursuant to 5 U.S.C. 5707(b) the General Services Administration sets the Federal

travel reimbursement rates. The Trade Adjustment Assistance program regulation at 617.28(b) requires Trade eligible customers who are participating in approved training programs outside their normal commuting area to be reimbursed for travel costs at an amount not to exceed the lesser of the actual cost of transportation by the

least expensive means that is reasonably available or the cost per mile at the

prevailing mileage rate authorized under the Federal Travel regulations. The Federal rate decreased from 0.54 cents per mile to 0.535 cents per mile effective January 1,

2017.

The Massachusetts Trade Adjustment Assistance program will reimburse Trade customers eligible for travel cost reimbursement at the new rate of 0.535 cents per mile for use of a privately owned vehicle and 0.505 for motorcycles. The

announced change is effective as of January 1, 2017.
