Subject: Trade Adjustment Assistance Relocation Towances Changes

Purpose:

To notify Local Workford Inventor and Boards, One-Stop Career Center Operators and local workford inventors at partners of changes regarding Relocation Allowances under the trade of Justment Assistance (TAA) Program resulting from enaction to of the Trade and Globalization Adjustment Assistance Act of 2009. This Issue ce replaces Policy Issuance No. 00-15, Relocation Allowances

<u>Under Trade A ustment Assistance Programs</u> (6/22/00).

Background: On Fruary 2009 the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) of

2009 we signed into law. The Trade and Globalization Adjustment Assistance Act of 2009, part of the ARRA, amended several elements of the TAA program.

One of the changes provides for an increase to the amount of Relocation

Allowances a TAA eligible individual may receive. This issuance provides notice of the revised amount and also provides procedural guidance with respect to

applying for TAA Relocation Allowances (ATTACHMENT A).

The issuance also includes new versions of the <u>Request for Relocation</u> <u>Allowances</u> application form (ATTACHMENT B) and the <u>Employment Verification Form For Relocation Allowances</u> (ATTACHMENT C).

Policy:

For any individual determined to be TAA eligible under a petition filed *on or after* May 18, 2009, the maximum amount of Relocation Allowances he/she may receive is increased to **100%** of the total allowable cost for Transportation, Lodging and Meals, Moving and Temporary Storage.

In addition, if eligible, the individual may receive a Lump Sum Allowance (Relocation Stipend) up to an amount not to exceed \$1,500.

For any eligible individual covered under a petition filed *before* May 18, 2009, the Relocation Allowance maximum amount for Transportation, Lodging and Meals, Moving and Temporary Storage remains **90%** of the total allowable costs.

If eligible for a Lump Sum Allowance (Relocation Stipend), the individual covered by a petition filed before May 18, 2009 may receive up to maximum of **\$1,250**.
