Hope all is well. Here is the summary of what was discussed on the MA TSRG call on Friday Jan 19, 2018.

- Attached, please find the agreed upon settings, capabilities, as well as the operational modes.
- Final language regarding the policy and the implementation timeline:
 - 1) ALL inverter based projects of ALL sizes with applications submitted prior to March 1, 2018 are exempt from ISO Ride-through Policy
 - 2) ALL inverter based projects 100kW or less with applications submitted on or after June 1, 2018 are subject to ISO Ride-through Policy
 - 3) ALL inverter based projects greater than 100KW with applications submitted on or after March 1, 2018 are subject to ISO Ride-through requirements.
- By August 1st 2018, it is desired that Inverter manufactures create and put into production (for MA projects) a standard 'NE Regional Setting Group' that aligns with all default settings within the ISO NE Ride-through Source Requirements document and made available to all parties. (ISO-NE agrees with this proposal)
- ISO-NE will develop a SRD, which will include all the technical requirements and the implementation timeline. ISO-NE will then submit the SRD to the utilities, NRTLs, and the inverter manufacturers. The SRD should indicate that the ride through requirements are for solar inverters only. This task must be completed by Jan 31, 2018
- ISO-NE will also fill out the inverter setting excel sheet, which will be provided by Brian Lydic. This excel sheet will be submitted to the inverter manufacturers.

Please let me know, if I missed anything.
