CONSENT AGREEMENT


The Board of Registration in Pharmacy ("Board") and Tura's Pharmacy (Pharmacy Registration No. 8420), located at 85 Summer Street in Kingston, Massachusetts ("Pharmacy"), do hereby stipulate and agree that the following information shall be entered into and become a permanent part of the file of the Pharmacy maintained by the Board:

1. The parties enter into this Consent Agreement ("Agreement") to resolve disputed matters arising out of a complaint pending against the Pharmacy as Complaint Docket No. PHA20100166 ("Complaint").
2. The Board held an Investigative Conference on this matter on February 8, 2011.
3. The Pharmacy acknowledges that on September 22, 2009, the Pharmacy incorrectly dispensed Glyburide 5mg rather than Oxybutynin 5mg, as alleged in the Complaint.
4. Accordingly, the Pharmacy acknowledges and agrees:
 - a. That the conduct of certain Pharmacy personnel in the filling and dispensing of the prescription which is the subject of the Complaint constitutes conduct in violation of accepted professional practice standards warranting disciplinary action by the Board, pursuant to M.G.L. c.112, §§ 42A and 61 and 247 CMR 9.01(1) and 10.03 (1) subsections (a), (k), (v) and (w);
 - b. The Pharmacy is hereby **REPRIMANDED** by the Board;
 - c. The Pharmacy shall submit a copy of the Pharmacy's Corrective Action Plan and the names and titles of retrained Pharmacy personnel (with signatures of retrained individuals affirming completion of retraining) to the Board within 30 days of the Effective Date of the Agreement; and
 - d. The Manager of Record of the Pharmacy shall complete the Board's Self-Assessment Inspection Form and submit written confirmation of completion to the Board within 30 days of the Effective Date of the Agreement; and
 - e. The Pharmacy shall implement BAR CODE scanning technology utilizing the Pharmacy's current QS-1 software system to enhance current quality assurance measures during the prescription verification process within six (6) months of the Effective Date of the Agreement.

5. The Agreement and its contents shall be incorporated into the records maintained by the Board. The Agreement is a public record subject to disclosure to the public and equivalent state licensing boards.
6. The Board agrees that in return for executing the Agreement, the Board will not advance the prosecution of the Pharmacy pursuant to the Complaint; any and all other rights of the Board to take action within the scope of its authority are expressly reserved.
7. The Pharmacy acknowledges and agrees that the decision to enter into the Agreement and to accept the terms and conditions herein described is a final act and is not subject to reconsideration or judicial review.
8. The Pharmacy acknowledges that legal counsel was consulted in connection with the decision to enter into the Agreement or, if not, that the Pharmacy had an opportunity to do so.
9. The Pharmacy acknowledges by executing this Agreement, the Pharmacy is waiving the right to a formal hearing at which the Pharmacy would possess the rights to confront and cross-examine witnesses, to call witnesses, to present evidence, to offer testify on its own behalf, to contest the allegations, to present oral argument, to appeal to court in the event of an adverse ruling, and all other rights set forth in G.L. c. 30A and 801 CMR 1.01 *et seq.* The Pharmacy representative executing this Agreement states that in executing this document entitled "Consent Agreement", the Pharmacy is knowingly and voluntarily waiving all right to a formal hearing and to all of the above listed rights.
