Apply today for a TURI grant to help you reduce your use of toxic chemicals. We can help you find a safer way to clean and sanitize at your facility!

Two categories of grants are available:



- Up to \$10,000 for small businesses that do not report under the Toxics Use Reduction Act or have fewer than 10 employees (www.turi.org/smallbusinessgrants).
- Up to \$30,000 for larger businesses that report toxic chemical use under TURA (www.turi.org/industrygrants).

Program funding is limited and submitting an application is no guarantee that a grant will be awarded.
