Item No. 110

**DEFINITION OF SHIPMENT**

Except as otherwise provided herein, a shipment is a quantity of freight received from one shipper, on one shipping order or bill of lading, at one point, at one time, for one consignee, at one delivery point, at one destination.

Item No. 430

**COD SHIPMENTS**

C.O.D. (Collection on Delivery) shipments will be accepted, subject to the following terms:

- (a) Amount to be collected must be clearly shown on a bill of lading by consignor.
- (b) Only cash, certified check, money order or cashier's check will be accepted by carrier, unless otherwise specifically directed by consignor.
- (c) Upon collection of a C.O.D. bill, carrier will remit same to consignor or other person designated as payee within ten (10) days from receipt thereof.
- (d) Carrier's fee for collecting and remitting the amount of each C.O.D. will be as follows:

- (e) Time consumed waiting for orders under this item will be considered part of the unloading time and detention charges will be assessed as provided in Item No. 500 herein.

**DETENTION - VEHICLES WITH POWER UNITS**

When, for reasons beyond the control of the carrier, and attributable to consignor or consignee, delays occur in the loading or unloading of shipments at origin or destination beyond the free time allowed for loading or unloading:

A charge of eight dollars for each fifteen (15) minute period or fraction thereof for all accumulated time beyond that allowed as free time shall be assessed. For the purpose of assessing charges under this Item, free time shall commence when carrier's vehicle is made available to shipper or consignee for the purpose of loading or unloading and shipper or consignee is notified to that extent. Time of arrival by carrier's equipment at points of loading or unloading shall appear on carrier's freight bills. Charges made under the terms of this Item shall be in addition to all other lawfully applicable charges set forth in tariff.

**RULES AND OTHER PROVISIONS WHICH GOVERN THE TARIFF**

Item No. 510

**DISTANCES**

Except as otherwise provided, where the rates set forth herein are determined by mileage, the mileage shall be that set forth in Tariff of Highway Mileage (see Item 100) when the shipments are interstate in nature, and the Milo Mileage Guide when the shipments are intrastate in nature. Said mileage to apply from origin to destination of shipment as indicated on the bill of lading or shipping documents.

**MAXIMUM CHARGE**

In no case shall the charge for any shipment to and from the same points, via the same route of movement, be greater than the charge for a greater quantity of the same commodity in the same shipping form and subject to the same packing provisions at the rate and weight applicable to such greater quantity of freight.

**PICK-UP AND DELIVERY SERVICE**

Unless otherwise provided, the rates published herein include pick-up and delivery of freight. "Pick-up" refers to the service of the carrier in calling for and receiving of freight and issuing receipts therefor at shipper's platform, doorway or any other place directly accessible to trucks. "Delivery" refers to the service of the carrier in delivering freight and taking receipts therefor at any platform, doorway, or any other place designated by the consignee, when directly accessible to trucks.

Nothing in this tariff shall require the carrier to collect and/or deliver freight at places where it is impracticable or unsafe to operate vehicles.

Pick-up and Delivery Service will be performed within the limits of all cities, towns or villages from, to, or between which rates apply.

**STOPOFFS**

Truckload shipments may be stopped at a point or points between origin and final destination, for the purpose of partial unloading, or split deliveries may be made a final destination.

(a) Only one bill of lading and one shipping order shall be issued for the entire shipment and such shipping papers shall show the name of only one shipper and one shipper's address and only one consignee and one delivery address.

(b) The names of places or addresses at which vehicles are to be stopped for partial unloading shall be shown in the body of the bill of lading and shipping order.

(c) A charge of \$67.50 per each stop for partial unloading or split delivery shall be assessed exclusive of final delivery.

(d) The rate from the original point of origin to final point of destination will apply on the total weight of the shipment plus the charge for each stop as set forth in paragraph (c).
