DECISION

LAXMINARAYAN LIQUOR, INC. DBA G & G LIQUORS, INC. 22 WESTFORD RD TYNGSBOROUGH, MA 01879

Laxminarayan Liquor, Inc. dba G & G Liquors, Inc. (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, August 7, 2012, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05(2), to wit: c.138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Bailey's Compliance Check Field Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts; and

2. Investigator Bailey's Compliance Check Field Report dated May 4, 2012.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

FACTS

- 1. On Friday, May 4, 2012 at approximately 6:30 p.m., Investigators Doyle and Bailey conducted an investigation of the business operation of Laxminarayan Liquor, Inc. dba G & G Liquors, Inc.
- 2. An underage operative working with investigators purchased an alcoholic beverage, a forty ounce (40 oz.) bottle of Bud Light beer for three dollars and thirty-nine cents (\$3.39). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2), to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, §34. Therefore, the Commission suspends the license for three (3) days of which three (3) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.
