The UMASS Amherst Police Department is currently accepting applications for entry level and lateral transfers.

Entry Level candidates must have either an associate degree or at least 60 credits towards a bachelor's degree <u>OR</u> high school diploma plus 4 years of military service, <u>OR</u> Correctional Officer Academy training and at least one year of service.

Lateral transfer applicants must have completed a full-time MPTC police academy. Out of state applicants who attended a police academy outside of Massachusetts should obtain an advisory letter from the Massachusetts Police Training Committee.

Competitive salary plus shift differential, education incentive, clothing allowance, paid holidays, accrued vacation and sick time, health/dental plans, employee/family tuition assistance, paid dry cleaning, work out on shift, 4/2 schedule, and numerous other benefits.

*Elevated starting pay for laterals based on years of service.

Shift bid three times a year, various units including Field Training Officer, Detective Bureau, Motorcycle Unit, Mounted Unit, Bicycle Unit, Community Outreach, EOD K9, Honor Guard, and various other opportunities!

Candidates selected to join the UMASS-Amherst Police Department will be required to successfully complete a comprehensive background investigation, oral interviews, and medical/psychological examination.
