The Monthly Chemical Addition Report only applies to you if your system adds chemicals to the water for treatment

Dear Public Water Suppliers:

The Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (MassDEP) Drinking Water Program (DWP) has updated the monthly Chemical Addition Report. In accordance with 310 CMR 22.15(4) all public water systems that add chemicals to their water must submit a monthly Chemical Addition Report to MassDEP/DWP.

310 CMR 22.15 (4) "Chemical Addition. "Every Supplier of Water shall report to the Department at least once each month the use of chemicals added to the water supply. Such reports shall include, but not be limited to, the name of the chemical, the amount added, the resulting concentration of the chemical in the water, and the reason for adding the chemical to the water."

The Chemical Addition Report helps to track the amount of chemical used, daily production of the water system, and the amount of chemical residual present in the distribution system. DEP/DWP reviews these reports to ensure that each public water system's treatment is operating efficiently and effectively to provide proper protection of drinking water. The updated report is compliant with the Drinking Water Standards, and includes guidance and instructions. See the attached report and instructions. An Excel version of the form will also be available.

To assist you to transition to the updated report and to correctly complete this monthly report, MassDEP/DWP is providing you with "Chemical Addition Report Training", **3.5 Training Contact Hours (TCHs). See the following page for the agenda and directions**. Please register for training by responding to this email or via email at program.director-dwp@mass.gov Subject: Chemical Addition Report. Include the date/location for the session you are interested in and the names of all attendees from your system. If you have any questions on the updated report, please let us know by responding to this email or include the questions with your registration. All questions will be responded to and/or compiled and addressed during the training.

Public Water Suppliers are expected to begin submitting the revised form/information no later than January 1, 2019. MassDEP is prepared to work with you individually as you transition into the updated form and/or information, especially systems with electronic tracking and reporting systems.
