**Subject:** Updated Labor Force Data for Workforce Area LMI Profiles

**Purpose:** To announce the availability of updates to labor force data that was provided in

the Annual Regional LMI Profiles published in March 2006.

**Background:** The Division of Career Services' Economic Analysis Office produces a series of

Annual Regional LMI Profiles for each of the state's workforce areas that provide labor force and other economic data. This information is used by workforce administrators as they plan for the upcoming fiscal year. The release date for the *Profiles* usually is in advance of regular yearly data updates (re-benchmarking) to the labor force series Thus, labor force data presented in each area's *Profile* is no

longer accurate once the re-benchmarked data have been released.

This communication provides direction on how areas may access the updated quarterly data to replace tables in the *Annual LMI Profiles* on massworkforce.org. The Economic Analysis Office also developed tables displaying re-benchmarked

annual average labor force data for calendar years 2004 and 2005.
