Directory Administration (DA) Account Cleanup Initiative



What is this initiative and Why are we doing it?

- A recent maintenance audit of the Directory Administration system identified a number of users in districts with overlapping accounts between:
 - personal accounts (Education Licensure and Recruitment - ELAR); and
 - work accounts (district/school)
- This overlap is against the Mass IT's security policy and must be corrected.



What needs to be done?

- Identify existing user accounts at EOE that have an ELAR consumer [applicant] role and other work/admin related security roles.
- Separate personal accounts (Education Licensure and Recruitment – ELAR) and work accounts (district/school).
 - The existing user account will ONLY have the ELAR consumer [applicant] role.
 - New [work] account will be created by EOE with all the work related security roles.



Current status & next steps

- All districts will be contacted with instructions to address this issue
- Pilot completed with 3 districts
- Cohort 1 currently under way with 10 districts

New in Edwin Analytics

New Reports (May 21st 2015)

- ***Students with IEPs Comparison Report***: provides aggregate information on how students who are on an IEP have performed compared to their general education peers over the past 5 years on MCAS as well as student indicators .
- ***CVTE Graduate Pathway Summary: MA Public Postsecondary***: provides aggregate postsecondary enrollment and outcome information for MA public CVTE high school graduates, providing insight into which students are enrolling into MA public postsecondary education and which are continuing with their vocational area of study.
- ***Equitable Access to Educators: Student Learning Experience***: provides aggregate and student level information about students' past classroom learning experiences which will inform local decisions around equitable access.
- ***District Disciplinary Removal Summary***: provides aggregate disciplinary removal trends in order to aid in understanding the removals which occur across all schools in a district.
- ***ELL Longitudinal Outcomes***: provides aggregate information on how students who exited from different types of programs perform once they enter the general population, in order to determine how to structure programs for a particular cohort of students requiring ELL services
