VMG employs 34 physicians, 62 advanced practitioners and 305 staff to provide comprehensive primary and specialty care to patients in Western Massachusetts. ## Briefly describe the nature and objectives of the proposed material change: VMG and Health New England ("HNE"), a Massachusetts Health Maintenance Organization propose to work more closely together by entering into a Professional Service Agreement ("PSA") and a Practice Lease Agreement (collectively, the "Affiliation Agreements"). VMG and HNE currently are parties to an agreement pursuant to which VMG providers are members of HNE's network of Participating Providers (the "HNE Participation Agreement"). The HNE Participation Agreement will continue. Similarly, VMG's agreements with other carriers and plans will continue and the PSA explicitly will provide that VMG will not be prohibited or restrained from contracting or participating in any way with any health plans, insurers or other payors. Pursuant to the PSA HNE will Tease's the VMG practitioners who will continue to provide the same high quality care for the same patients. Pursuant to a Practice Lease Agreement, HNE will lease the VMG physical assets and staff. Pursuant to the Affiliation Agreements, HNE will make fair market value payments to VMG. VMG will continue its corporate existence, will continue to own its assets, and employ its own practitioners and staff and will continue to operate subject to its existing Board and shareholder governance. VMG will retain complete clinical autonomy and startificant independence in all other cares. There will be a Joint Operating Committee made up of representatives of VMG and HNE that will review and approve annual budgets and focus on the objectives of the proposed affiliation. Those objectives are as follows: Improvements in the quality and availability of Patient Care Services; Increased integration and coordination between the Parties; Promotion of the Triple Aim through: Improvements in population health in Hampshire and Franklin Counties Improvements in the experience of patients served by VMG improved use of resources and management of care Growth and development of the VMG practice to allow the practice to treat more patients within a patient centered medical home setting Potential for improving the capabilities of the practice to deliver effective care Potential for cost savings Other opportunities to improve the operation or function of VMG and HNE Planning for urgent or after-hours care improvements or replacements to current practice infrastructure Additional population health management infrastructure to achieve best practice clinical and financial outcomes including potential for HNE assistance in improving IT operations Methods for attracting new practitioners to the VMG practice sites Potential use of new technologies such as tele-medicine and remote health monitoring Billing, contracting, and financial advice and support Using VMG facilities as the site for HNE community benefit activities, such as public health education or health promotion events Identification of opportunities for VMG and HNE to work together to provide greater value to the communities served general, the Affiliation Agreements are intended to increase the financial stability of VMG and to ensure and improve its ability to continue to supply high quality primary care to the communities it now serves 15. Briefly describe the anticipated impact of the proposed material change: VMG has not undertaken any formal analysis of the anticipated impact of the proposed material change. VMG and HNE believe that based on: 1) VMG's "track record", 2) the objectives of the proposed affiliation and 3) the terms of the Affiliation Agreements, population health will be improved. The affiliation will not change VMG's current prices; HNE's provider agreement with VMG will remain in place, and VMG or an agent for VMG will continue to negotiate future agreements with other carriers. . Market share, referral patterns and payer mix are not expected to change, although it is hoped that the affiliation will facilitate future growth of VMG. Similarly, the service area, service lines and service mix are not expected to change.
