



# Voluntary National Shellfish Regulatory Program Standards (VNSRPS)



- A guide to design and manage a shellfish regulatory program
- A tool to evaluate the effectiveness of food safety interventions
- Used in assessing for Grants/Agreements\*

# Milk/Shellfish Cooperative Agreement



- > Training and Equipment Categories
- Priorities



#### M/S CA Year One



- \$675,000 awarded for 2017
  - \$303,455 for Shellfish
- Category 1: 2017 Annual Training Needs Grants (\$500 up to an average of \$2,000 per person/per course)
  - \$237,500 for Shellfish
- Category 2: Equipment Grants (up to \$3,000 for Milk and up to \$5,000 for Shellfish)
  - \$66,250 for Shellfish

#### M/S CA Year Two



- \$675,000 awarded for 2018
  - \$211,975 for Shellfish
- Category 1: 2018 Annual Training Needs Grants (\$500 up to an average of \$2,000 per person/per course)
  - \$211,975 for Shellfish
- Category 2: Equipment Grants (up to \$3,000 for Milk and up to \$5,000 for Shellfish)
  - \$0 for Shellfish

#### M/S CA Year Two Reallocation



#### \$161,000 reallocated from 2017 YEAR ONE

 Category 2: Year Two 2018 Equipment Grants (up to \$3,000 for Milk and up to \$5,000 for Shellfish)\*



#### M/S CA Year Three



- \$997,676 awarded for 2019
  - \$319,747 for Shellfish
- Category 1: 2019 Annual Training Needs Grants (\$500 up to an average of \$2,000 per person/per course)
  - \$319,747 for Shellfish
- Category 2: Equipment Grants
  - TBD for Shellfish

Connecticut	\$7,899
Maine	\$18,883
New Hampshire	\$995
New Jersey*	\$10,520
Pennsylvania*	\$899
Rhode Island	\$11,143

## CY2019 Equipment



- ➤ Portal opened April 3, 2019
- ➤ Portal closes May 8, 2019
- ➤ Current returned fund balance (Year 1 + 2 Carryover): \$152,354
- ➤ Anticipated total balance: \$200,000 to \$300,000
- ➤ Goal: Maximize awards to State Programs
- State labs may apply
