

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT VOTER REGISTRATION

Dear Applicant or Member:

The National Voter Registration Act of 1993 requires MRC to give you the opportunity to register to vote. Your decision to register to vote will NOT affect your eligibility for benefits. A mail-in voter registration form is enclosed in the middle of this welcome package. Or If you or any household member age 18 or over would like to register to vote, click on the link below (or copy/paste into your web browser) for a voter registration form:

When you get the form, fill it out and send it to your city or town hall or you can return to MRC Connect. If you have any questions about the voter registration process, or if you need help filling out the form, you can call MRC Connect Information and Referral Line at 617-204-3665 or 1-800-245-6543 OR call one of the listed telephone numbers, or visit a local Town Hall office.

Remember: You will not be registered to vote until you send the filled-out voter registration form to your local city or town hall or return to MRC Connect. Your local election department will let you know in writing when your voter registration has been processed. If you do not get written notification within a reasonable time, contact your local city or town hall election department for more information.

your right to choose your own political party or other political preference, you may file a complaint with:
