


EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Town of Wakefield, Massachusetts has adopted the Transparency best practice as part of a Community Compact agreement signed with the Baker-Polito Administration in December 2015. The Town retained the services of Visual Government (VisGov) to deploy and host their open-source Visual Budget solution. Visual Budget allows Wakefield's citizens to interact with the Town's budget and view a breakdown of where their tax dollars are being allocated. It's a powerful tool that can be more engaging to the public than traditional text and spreadsheet documents.



COMMUNITY PROFILE

The Town of Wakefield is located in eastern Massachusetts in Middlesex County. A suburban community located near Route 128, Wakefield is best known for its historical New England appearance and Lake Quannapowitt, which borders Wakefield's common and is a popular local recreation spot.

As technology evolves, so do expectations around how government provides services to citizens using technology. These services include digital financial transparency tools which allow citizens to see Town financial transactions and hold Town leadership accountable for every dollar spent. Municipal finance can be difficult to understand and "telling the complete story" using only static documents can lead to misunderstandings about how taxpayer money is spent.

As shown in the below screenshots, the tool – accessible at wakefield.visgov.com – has three sections: revenues, which shows funds coming into the Town; expenses, which shows funds leaving the town; and funds & reserves which shows funds on hand in various accounts held by the Town. This interactive method of looking at the budget (including a per taxpayer calculation) is critical for informed transparency and building trust in government.


