A resident of Boston, Terry Boutelle was born in rural Massachusetts, and spent her childhood exploring the surrounding woods and pastures. She studied psychology, philosophy, theology, and art history at Boston College in the 70s and later received her MFA at MassArt's low residency program at the Fine Arts Work Center in Provincetown. Her work is in collections throughout the U.S.
