CONSENT AGREEMENT FOR REPRIMAND

The Massachusetts Board of Registration in Pharmacy (Board) and Walgreens #17637 (Pharmacy or Licensee), a pharmacy licensed by the Board, license no. DS90223, do hereby stipulate and agree that the following information shall be entered into and become a permanent part of the Pharmacy's record maintained by the Board:

1. The Pharmacy acknowledges the Board opened a Complaint against its Massachusetts pharmacy license related to the conduct set forth in Paragraph 2, docketed as PHA-2021-0118 and PHA-2024-0069 (collectively, the Complaint).
2. The Pharmacy and the Board agree to resolve the Complaint without making any admissions or findings and without proceeding to a formal adjudicatory hearing. The Complaint alleges the following:

The Pharmacy failed to appoint an interim Manager of Record (MOR) or file for a new MOR for a new MOR after the MOR's extended leave exceeded the policy limit.

3. The Board and Licensee acknowledge and agree that based upon the information described in Paragraph 2, the Board could find the Licensee in violation of Title 247 of the Massachusetts Code of Regulations Section 6.10 (1) and Board Policy 2022-02 warranting disciplinary action by the Board pursuant to Massachusetts General Law (MGL) Chapter 112, Sections 42A and 61 and 247 CMR Section 10.03 (1)(a).
4. The Pharmacy agrees that the Board shall impose a REPRIMAND on its license based on the facts described in Paragraph 2, effective as of the date on which the Board signs this Agreement (Effective Date).
5. The Board agrees that in return for the Pharmacy's execution and successful compliance with all the requirements of this Agreement, the Board will not prosecute the Complaint.
6. The Pharmacy understands that it has a right to formal adjudicatory hearing concerning the Complaints and that during said adjudication the Pharmacy would possess the right to confront and cross-examine witnesses, to call witnesses, to present evidence, to testify on

its own behalf, to contest the allegations, to present oral argument, to appeal to the courts, and all other rights as set forth in the Massachusetts Administrative Procedures Act, MGL Chapter 30A, and the Standard Adjudicatory Rules of Practice and Procedure, 801 CMR Section 1.01, *et seq.* The Pharmacy further understands that by executing this Agreement, the Pharmacy is knowingly and voluntarily waiving its right to a formal adjudication of the Complaints.

7. The Pharmacy acknowledges that it has been at all times represented by Counsel or otherwise free to seek and use legal counsel in connection with the Complaints and this Agreement.
8. The Pharmacy acknowledges that after the Effective Date, the Agreement constitutes a public record of disciplinary action by the Board subject to the Massachusetts Public Records Law, MGL Chapter 4, Section 7. The Board may forward a copy of this Agreement to other licensing boards, law enforcement entities, and other individuals or entities as required or permitted by law.
9. The Pharmacy understands and agrees that entering into this Agreement is a voluntary and final act and not subject to reconsideration, appeal or judicial review.
10. The individual signing this Agreement certifies that they are authorized to enter into this Agreement on behalf of the Pharmacy, and that they have read this Agreement.
