CONSENT AGREEMENT FOR REPRIMAND

The Massachusetts Board of Registration in Pharmacy ("Board") and Walgreens Pharmacy # 4595 ("Pharmacy" or "Licensee"), a pharmacy licensed by the Board, license number DS2970, do hereby stipulate and agree that the following information shall be entered into and become a permanent part of the Pharmacy's record maintained by the Board:

- 1. The Pharmacy acknowledges that the Board opened a Complaint against its Massachusetts pharmacy license related to the conduct set forth in Paragraph 2, identified as Docket Number PHA-2017-0031 ("Complaint").
- 2. The Board and the Pharmacy acknowledge and agree to the following facts:
 - a. On or about January 31, 2017, the Pharmacy reported that it lost approximately 90 tablets of D-amphetamine salt combo 20 mg.
 - b. The Pharmacy's investigation did not determine the cause of the loss of the 90 tablets of D-amphetamine salt combo 20 mg.
- 3. The Pharmacy acknowledges that the facts described in Paragraph 2 constitute a violation of 247 CMR 9.01(14) and warrant disciplinary action by the Board under M.G.L. c. 12, §§ 42A & 61 and 247 CMR 10.03(1)(a) & (v).
- 4. The Pharmacy agrees that the Board shall impose a REPRIMAND on its license based on the facts admitted in Paragraph 2, effective as of the date on which the Board signs this Agreement ("Effective Date").
- 5. The Board agrees that in return for the Pharmacy's execution and successful compliance with all the requirements of this Agreement, the Board will not prosecute the Complaint.
