J & K ENTERPRISES, LLC DBA WHISKEY HILL LIQUORS 2370 MAIN ST. WARREN, MA 01092 LICENSE#: 133000020 HEARD: 07/24/2012

J & K Enterprises, LLC dba Whiskey Hill Liquors (the "Licensee") holds an all-alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, July 24, 2012, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2), to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Kujawski's Compliance Check Field Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

- 1. Investigator Kujawski's Compliance Check Field Report dated March 10, 2012;
- 2. The Licensee's Stipulation of Facts;
- 3. Picture of Underage Operative; and
- 4. One can of Bud Light beer.

FACTS

- 1. On Saturday, March 10, 2012, at approximately 6:50 p.m., Investigators Keefe and Kujawski conducted an investigation of the business operation of J & K Enterprises, LLC dba Whiskey Hill Liquors.
- 2. An underage operative working with investigators purchased an alcoholic beverage, a twenty-four ounce (24 oz.) can of Bud Light beer for two dollars and forty cents (\$2.40). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2), to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, §34. Therefore, the Commission suspends the license for three (3) days of which three (3) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.
