The purpose of this online meeting is to discuss in greater detail the results from several recently completed Evaluation, Measurement and Verification ("EM&V") Studies. The Program Administrators' ("PAs") Evaluation Management Committee ("EMC") will host this webinar. "Massachusetts Residential New Construction Net Impacts Report" and "Northeast Residential Lighting Hours-of-Use Study" will be presented by NMR Group. "Massachusetts Low Income Metering Study" will be presented by The Cadmus Group. The objective is to illuminate, make more transparent, and engender greater confidence with regard to the data recorded and quantified by the PAs in their pursuit of "all available energy efficiency and demand reduction resources that are cost effective or less expensive than supply" pursuant to the mandate of M.G.L. c.25, § 21.

These matters all relate to the continuing review and evaluation of the Three-Year Energy Efficiency Investment Plans of electric distribution companies, natural gas distribution companies, and municipal aggregators.
