Subject:	Webinars for Planning and Implementing Summer Jobs Program for Youth	
Purpose:	To notify Local Workforce Investment Boards, One-Stop Career Center Operators and local workforce investment partners and youth program vendors of three webinars related to planning and implementing summer jobs programs for youth, scheduled for dates in June and July 2009.	
Background:	The Commonwealth Corporation and the Department of Workforce Development invite managers and practitioners to participate in a series of webinars designed to help staff in youth programs accomplish the following:	
	 share effective practices in starting up youth summer job programs; manage program reporting requirements; develop media strategies to build community support; and create meaningful year-round programs. 	
	The webinar series will prove valuable for both current staff and for new staff hired under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) funding as well as regular Workforce Investment Act (WIA) programs, YouthWorks, and the anticipated summer jobs program funded through the Executive Office of Public Safety and Security (EOPSS).	

The three part webinar series will provide an interactive opportunity to exchange promising practices and resources related to essential components of summer jobs programs.

<u>The first webinar (June 5th)</u> will focus on getting summer programs started. Topics include documenting youth eligibility, job site development and support, and preparing youth for summer jobs. Exploring ways to fully engage youth with multiple challenges will also be covered.

<u>The second webinar (June 9th)</u> will focus on gathering reporting data, using IT reporting infrastructure (this is not MOSES training), and creating a media strategy.

<u>The third webinar (July 22^{nd})</u> focusing on the development of strong year-round jobs programs will highlight ways to plan jobs programs that effectively engage and appeal to youth, particularly older youth.
