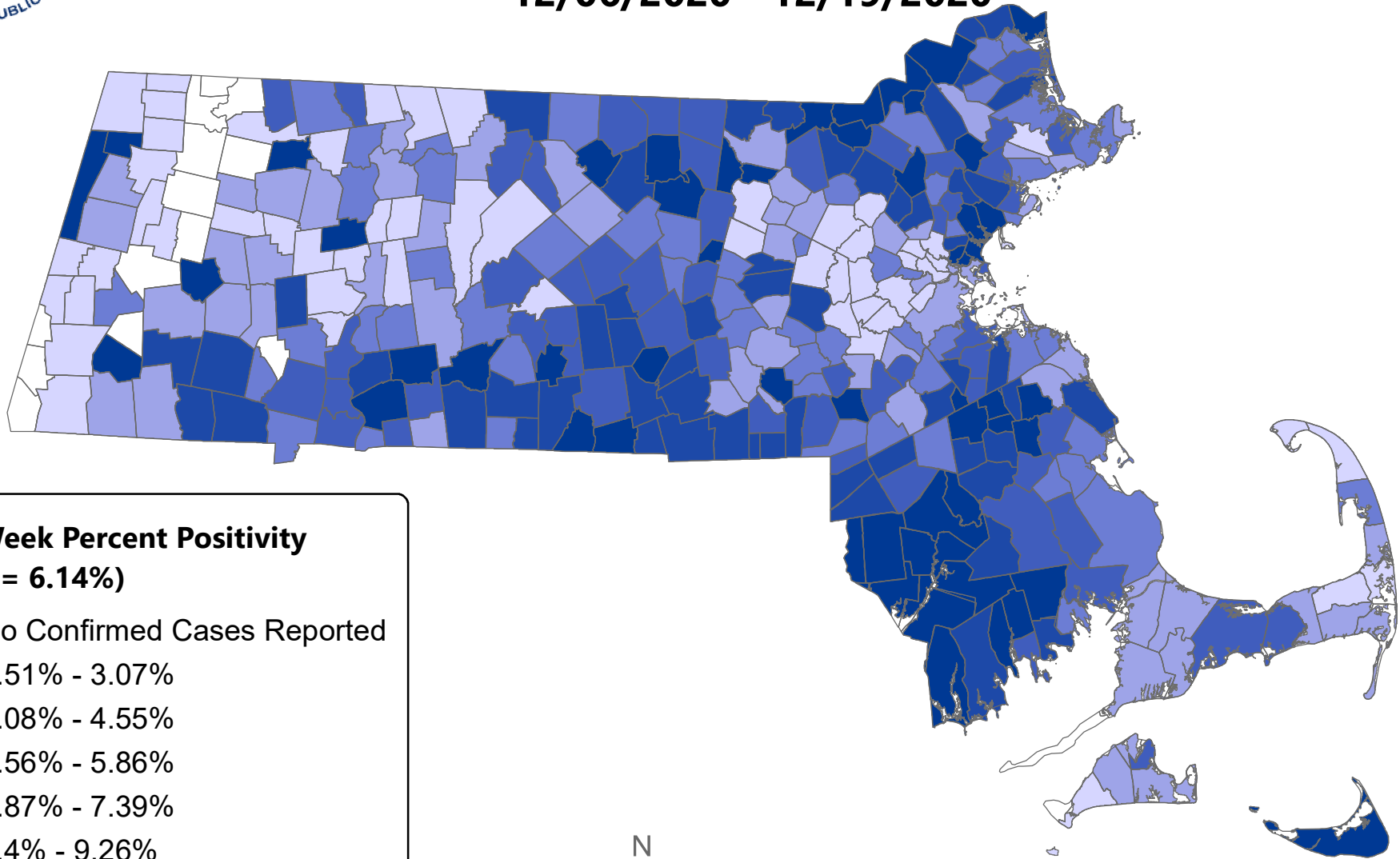

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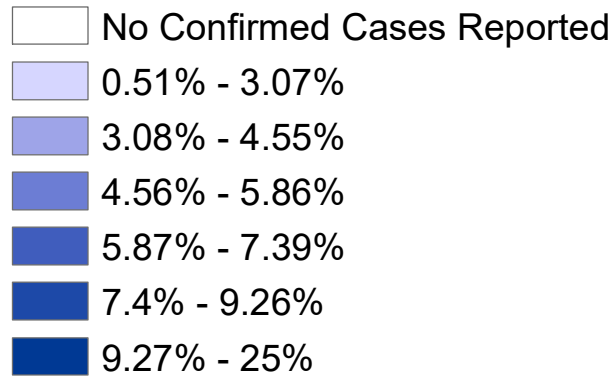

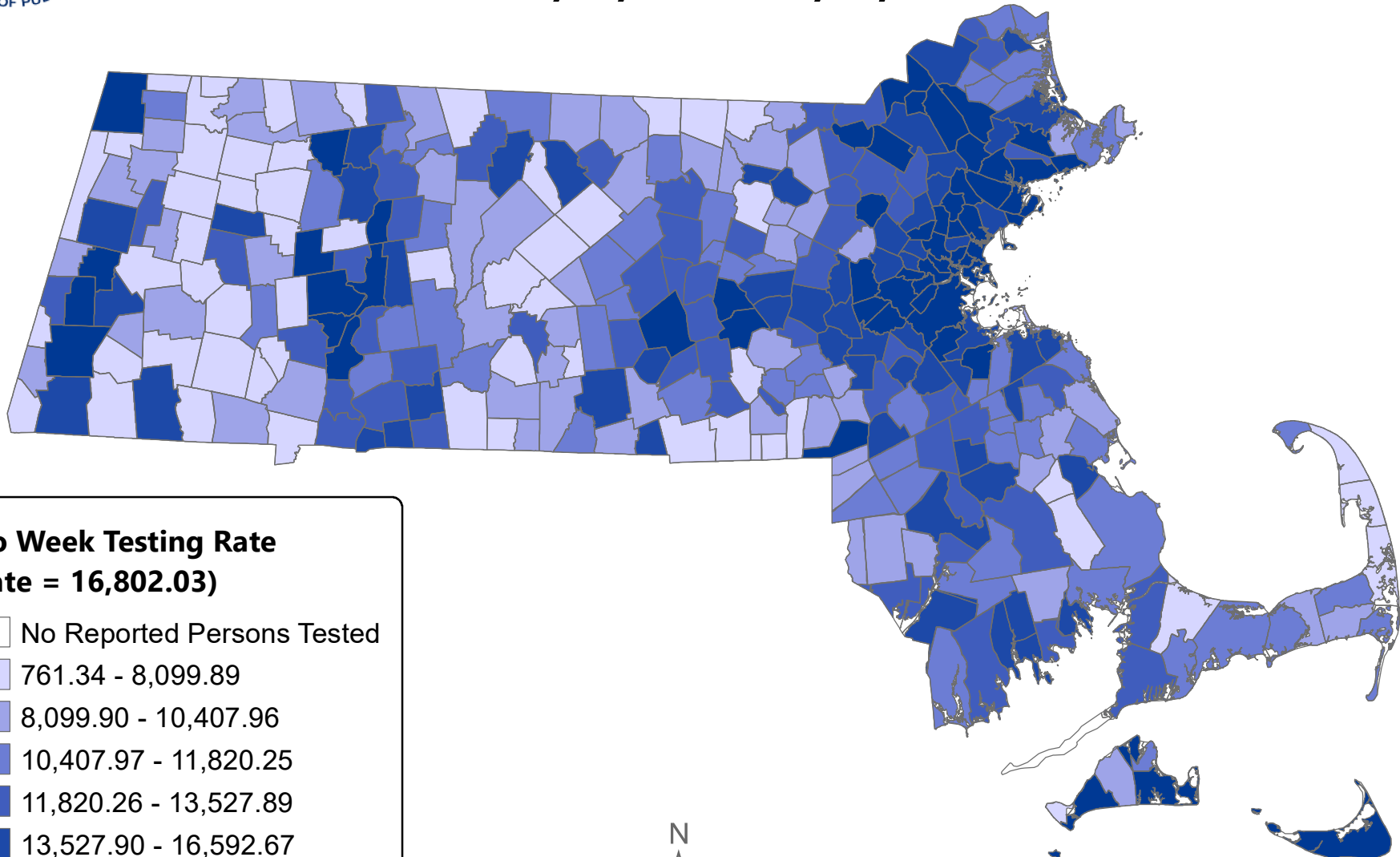

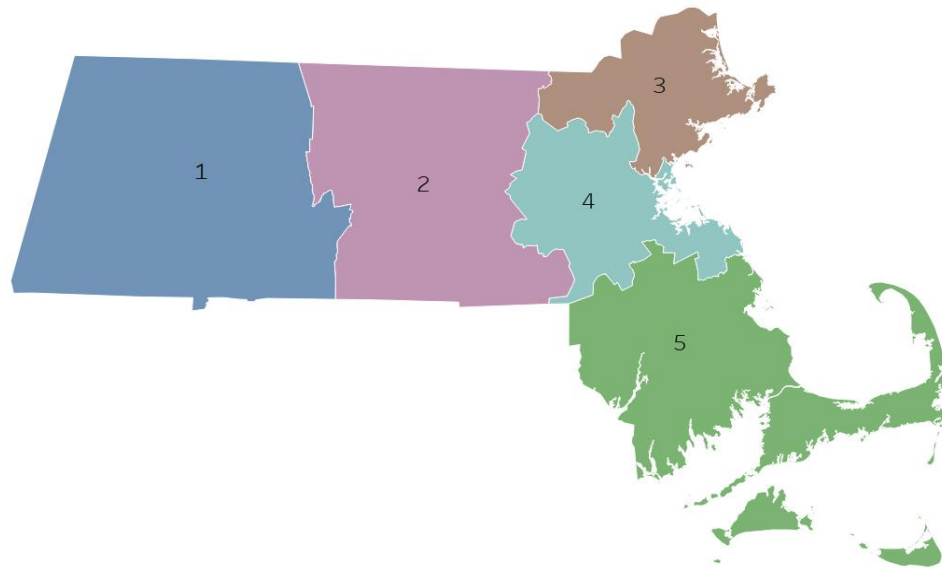

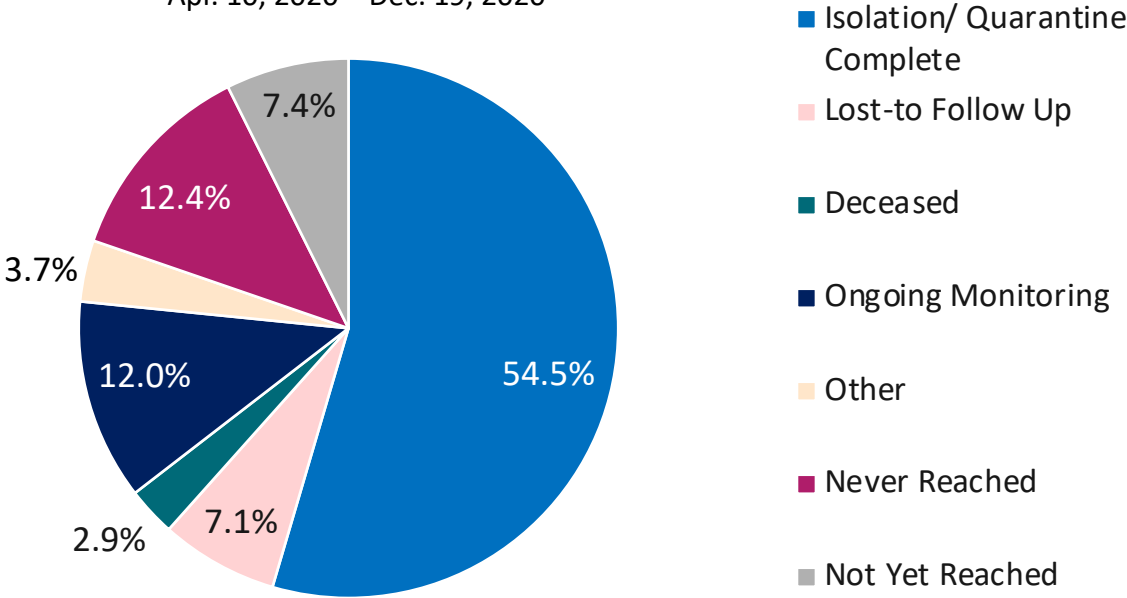

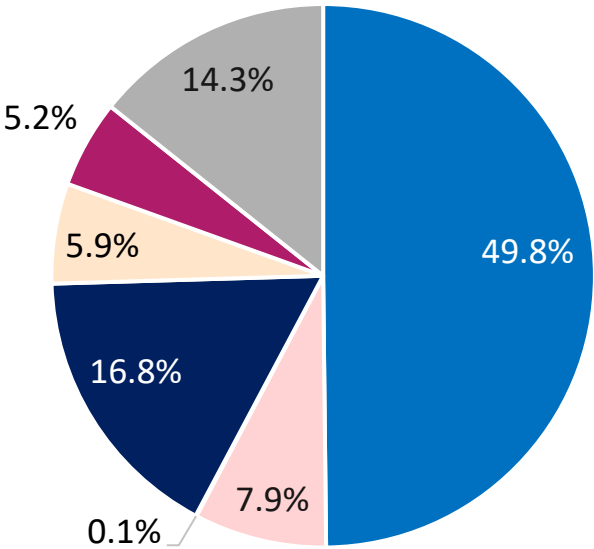

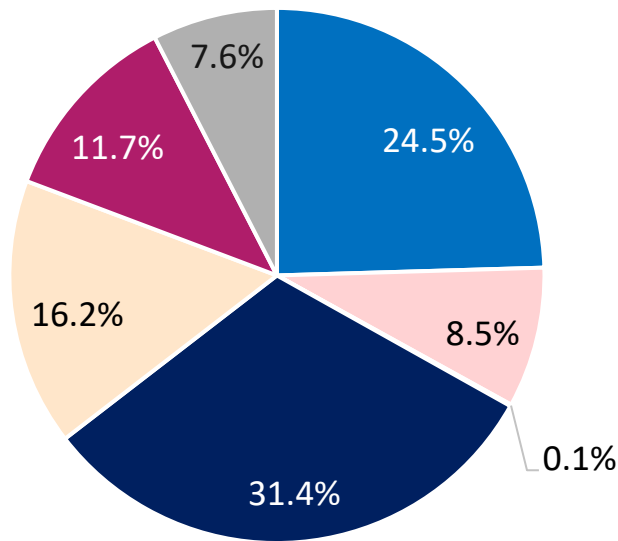

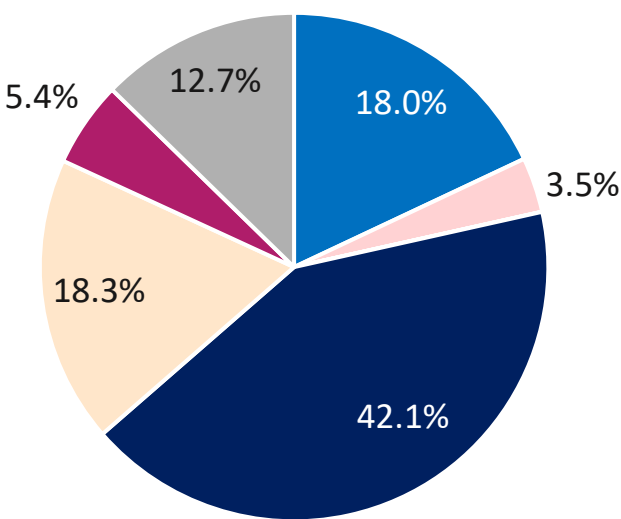

Massachusetts Residents Quarantined due to COVID-19

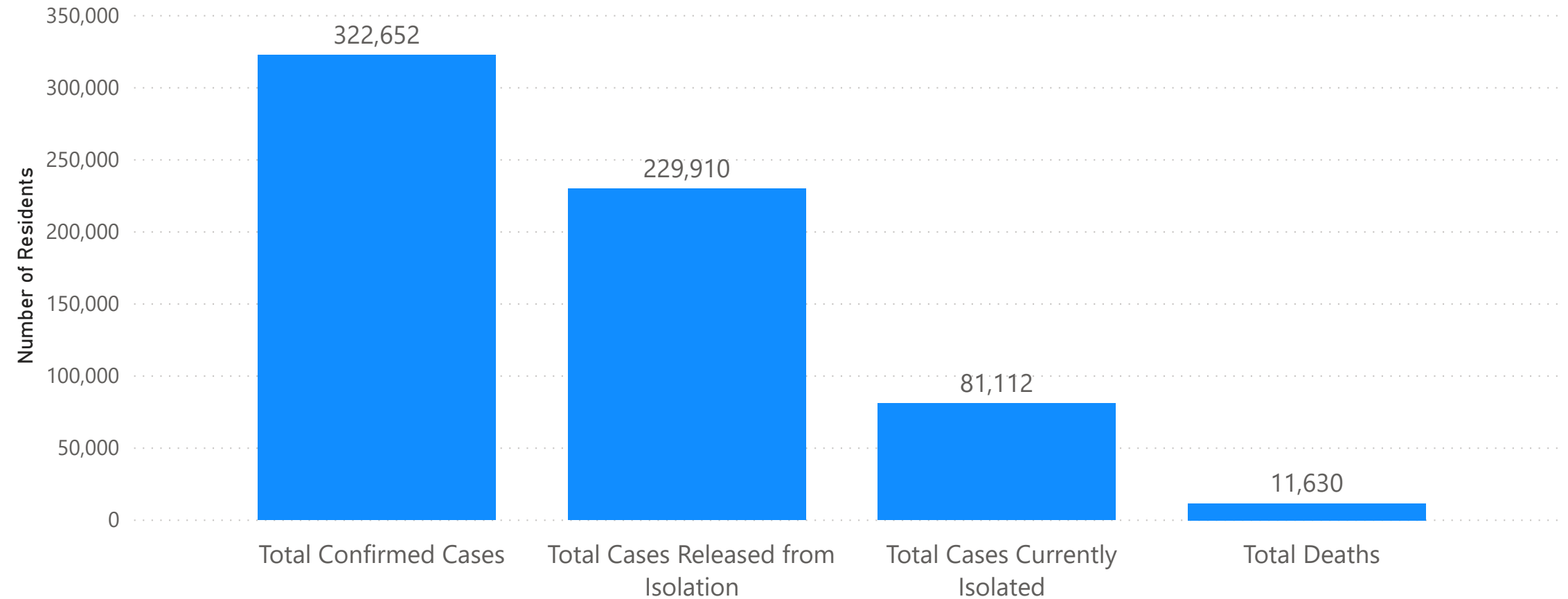

Active COVID-19 Cluster Explanation

Clusters Within Long-Term Care Facilities

- A confirmed case is defined as a staff or resident with a new positive COVID-19 test result.
- Confirmed cases are reported by each facility in aggregate, at least once a week, and are assigned to the week in which the data are submitted.
- A “new” cluster is defined as two or more confirmed cases in a facility that has not reported a confirmed case in the prior 4 weeks.
- A cluster is deemed closed when a facility has gone two incubation periods (28 days) without reporting a confirmed case among staff or residents.

Household Clusters

- A household “cluster” is defined as two or more confirmed Massachusetts cases, who reside at the same address with COVID-19 infection within 28 days of each other, and who are not associated with another cluster.
- The date assigned to each confirmed case’s event is that of the first positive lab date.
- A cluster is deemed closed once two incubation periods (28 days) have passed from the last confirmed case.

All Other Clusters

- All other “clusters” are defined as two or more confirmed Massachusetts cases with a common exposure.
- The date assigned to each confirmed case’s event is that of the first positive lab date.
- The date assigned to each contact is that of the date they were linked to the cluster.
- A cluster is deemed closed once two incubation periods (28 days) have passed from the last confirmed case.

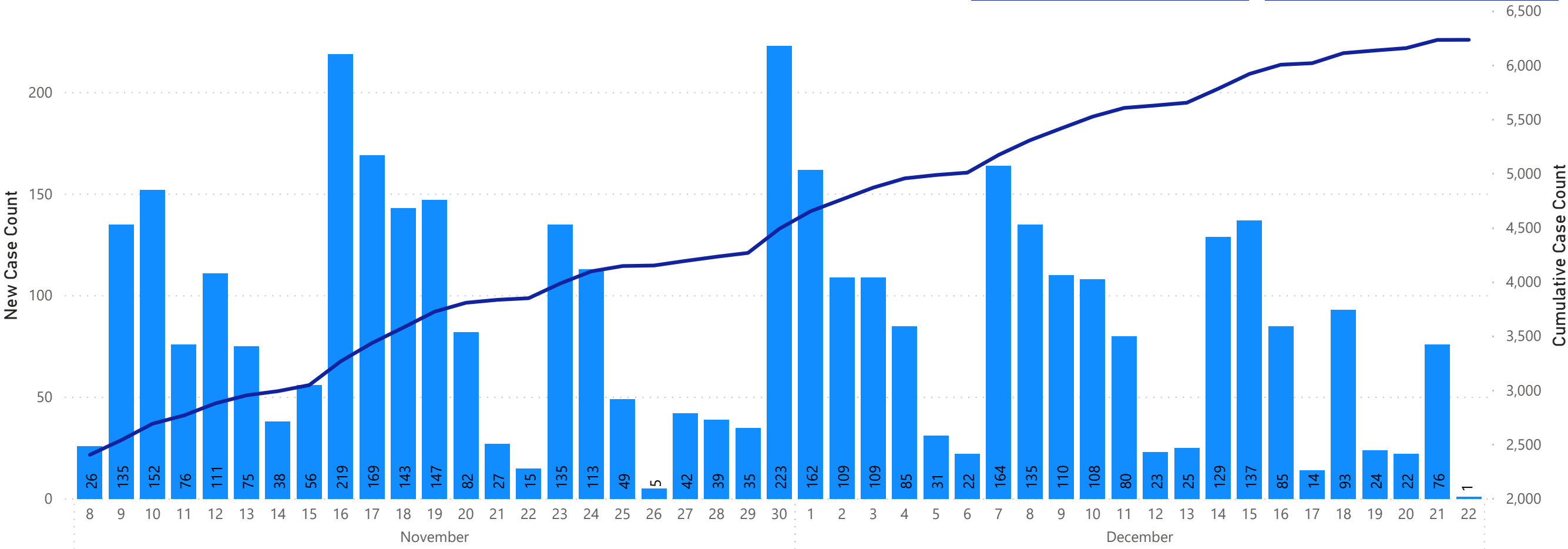

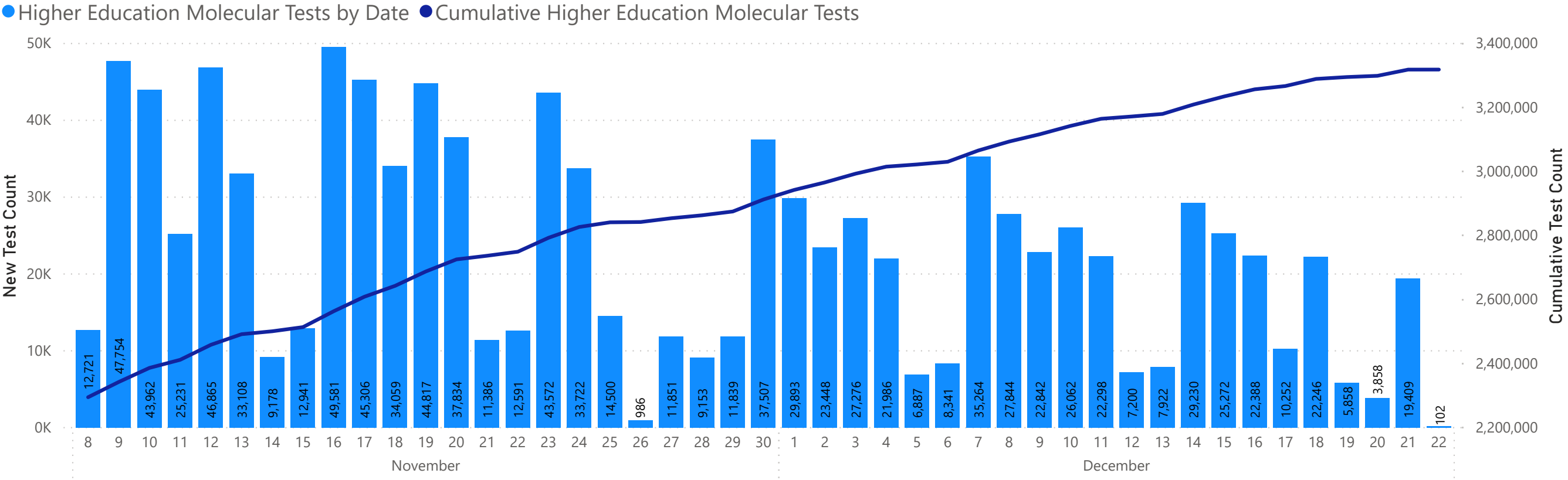

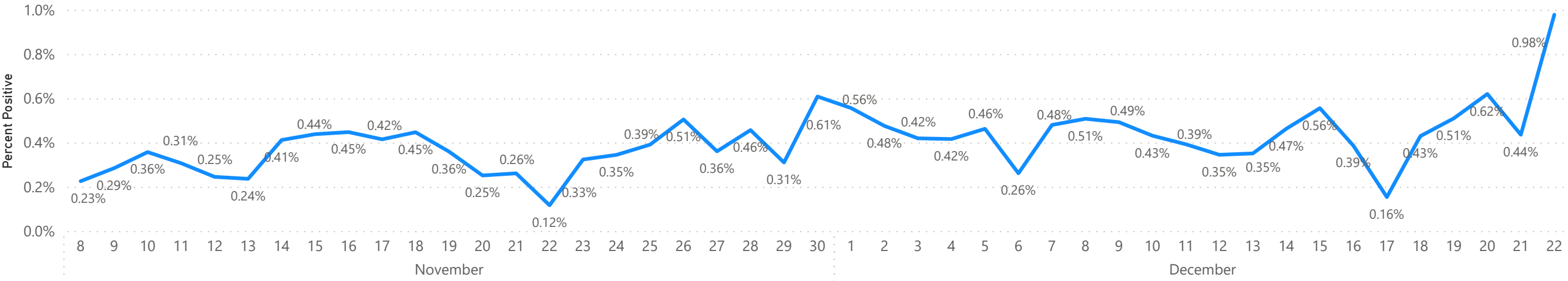

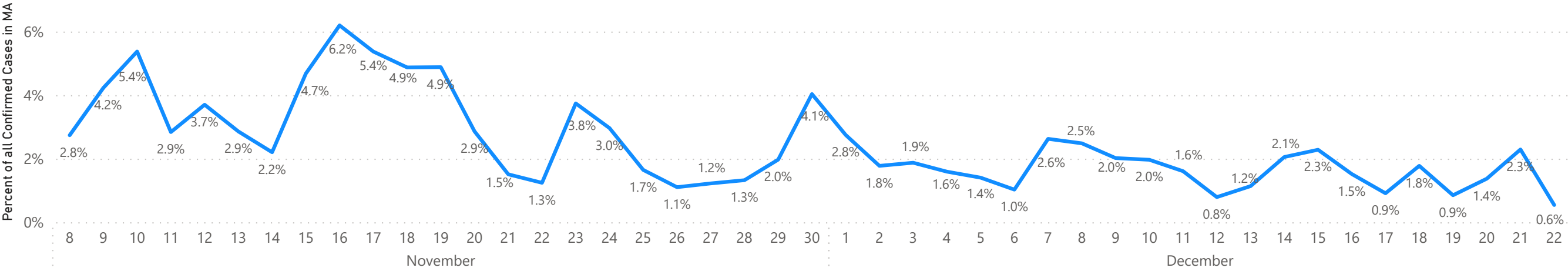

Percent of All Confirmed Cases in MA that are Associated with Higher Education Testing by Date of Test



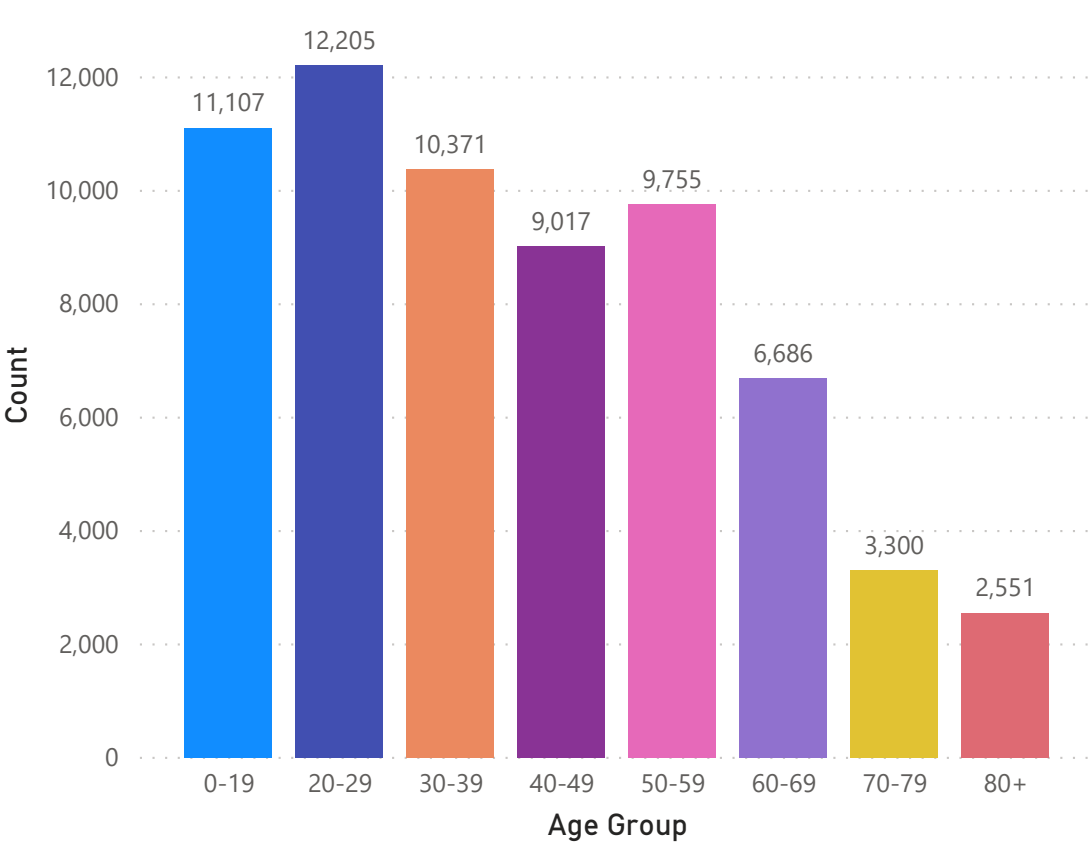

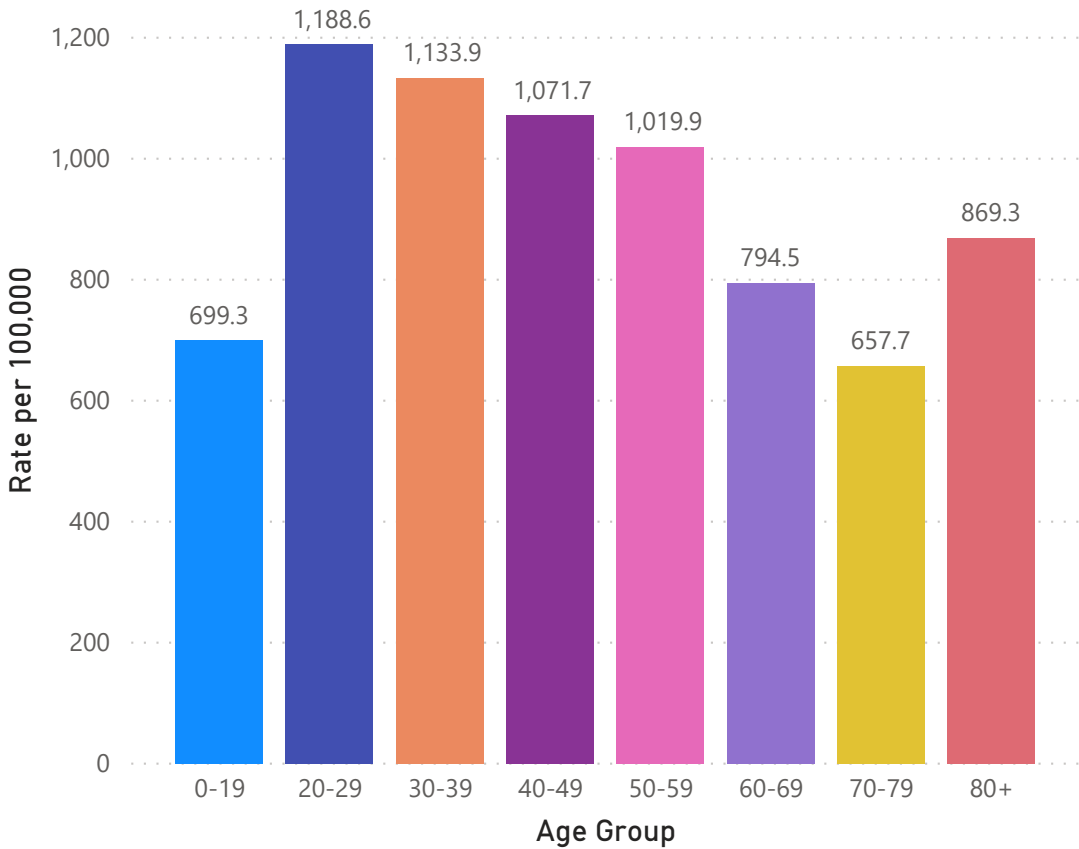
Cases and Case Rate by Age Group for Last Two Weeks

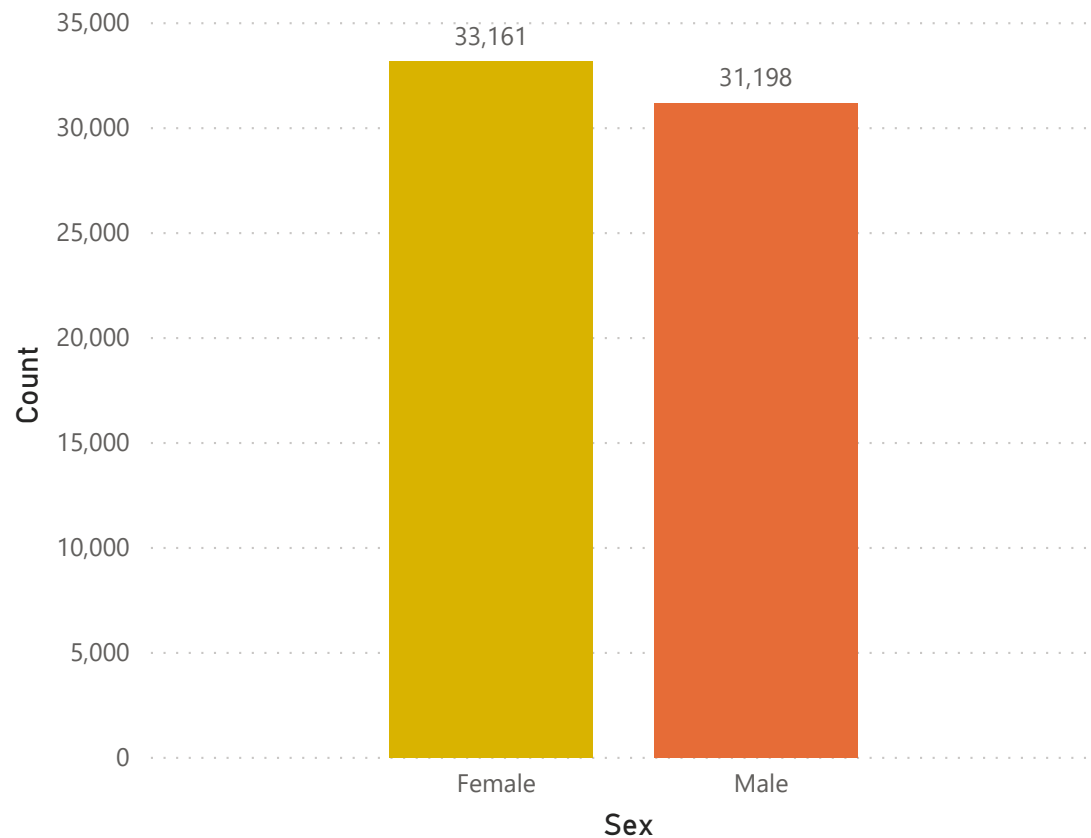

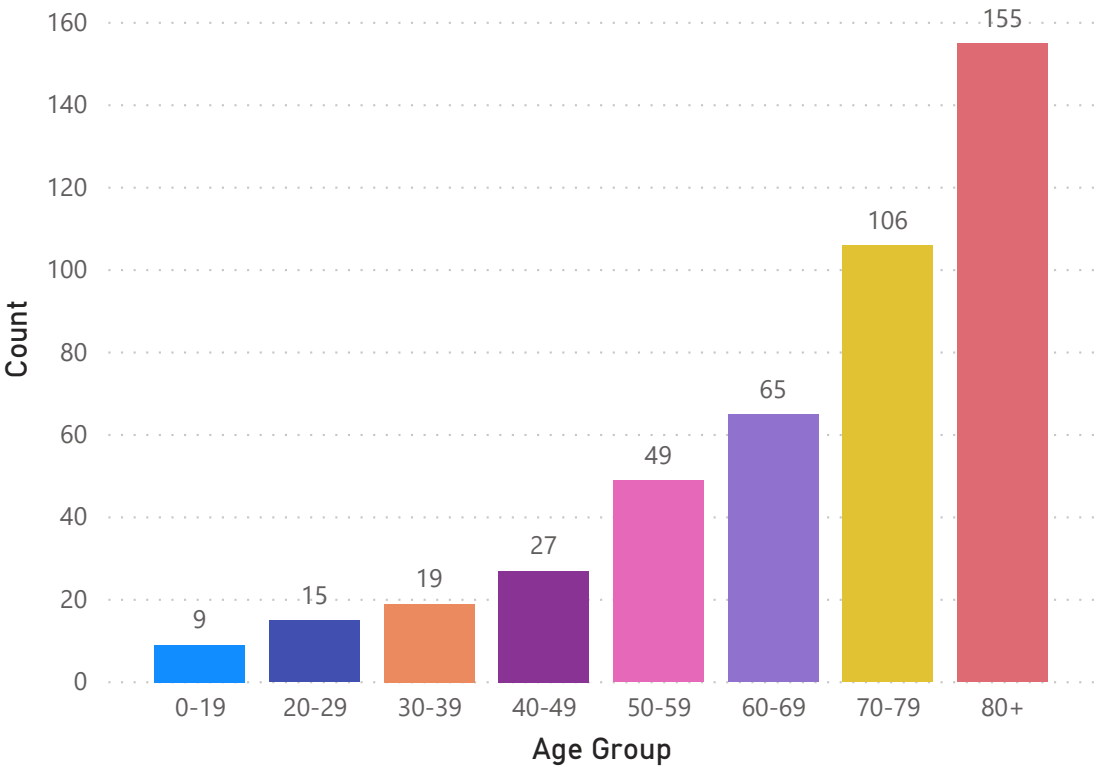

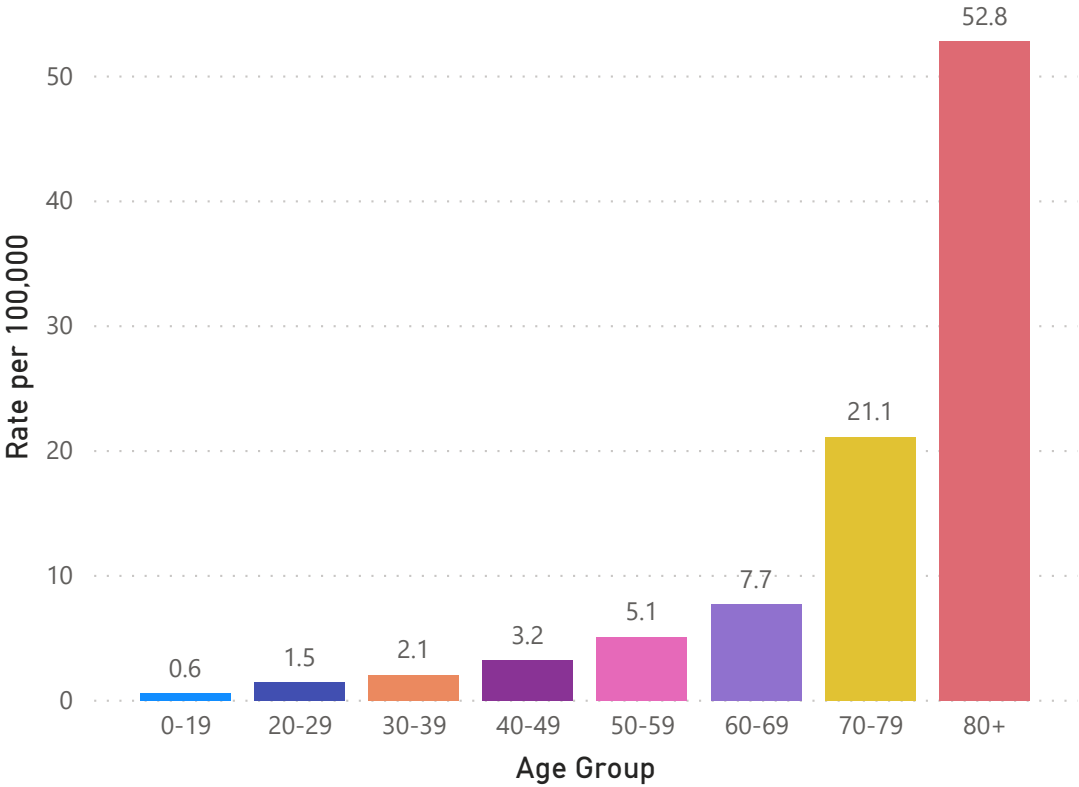

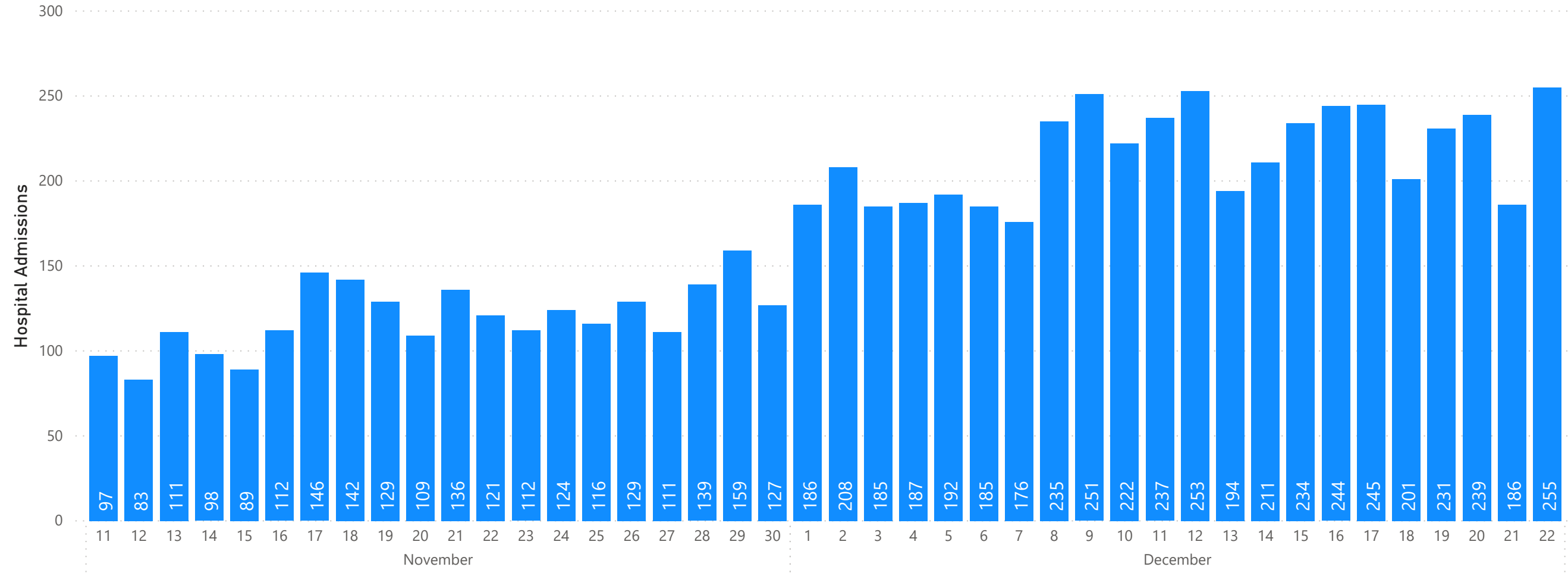

Confirmed COVID-19 Hospital Admissions by Day



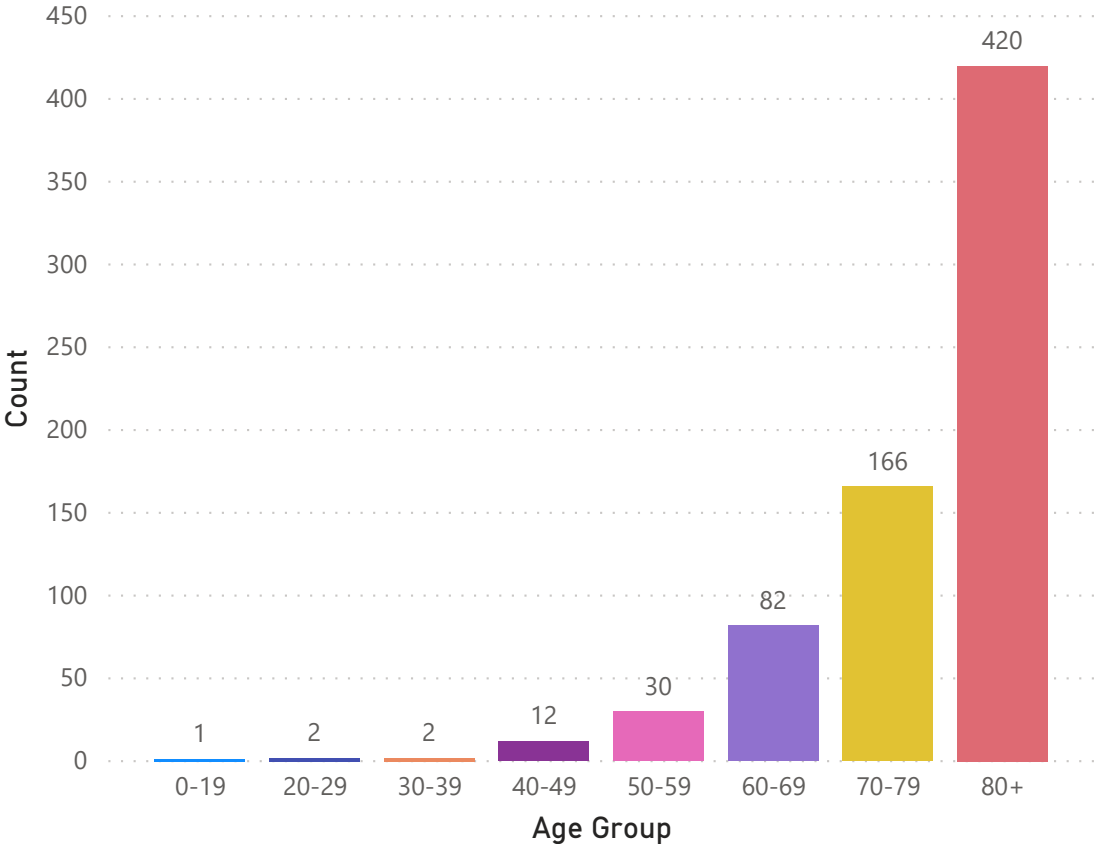

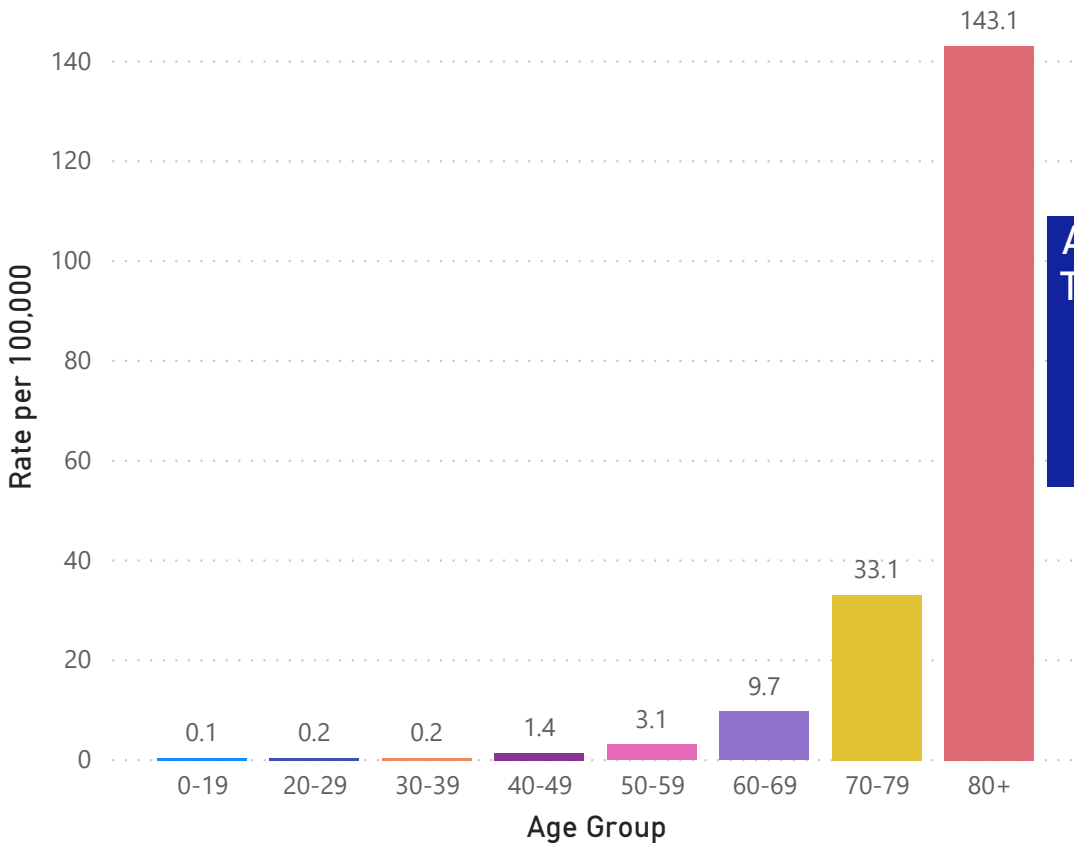

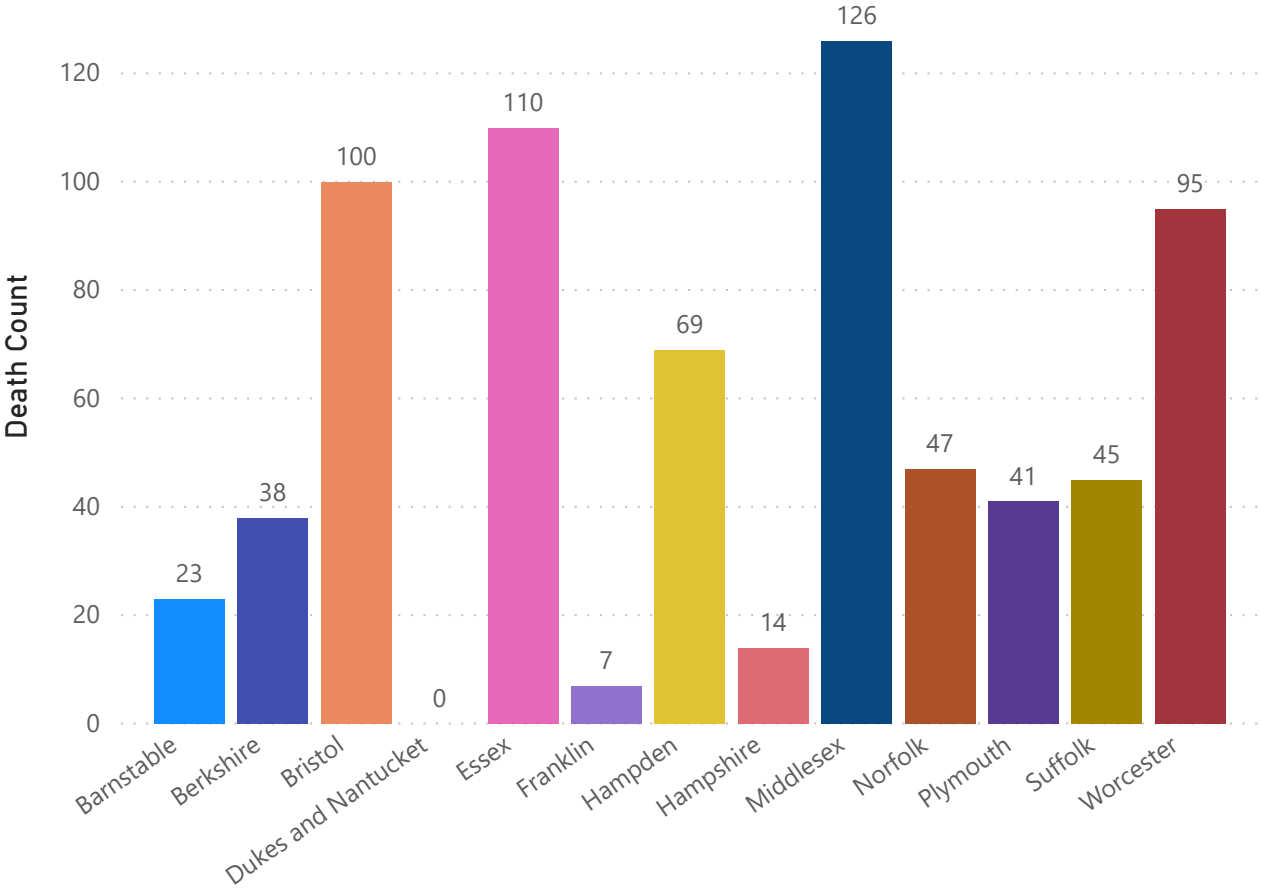

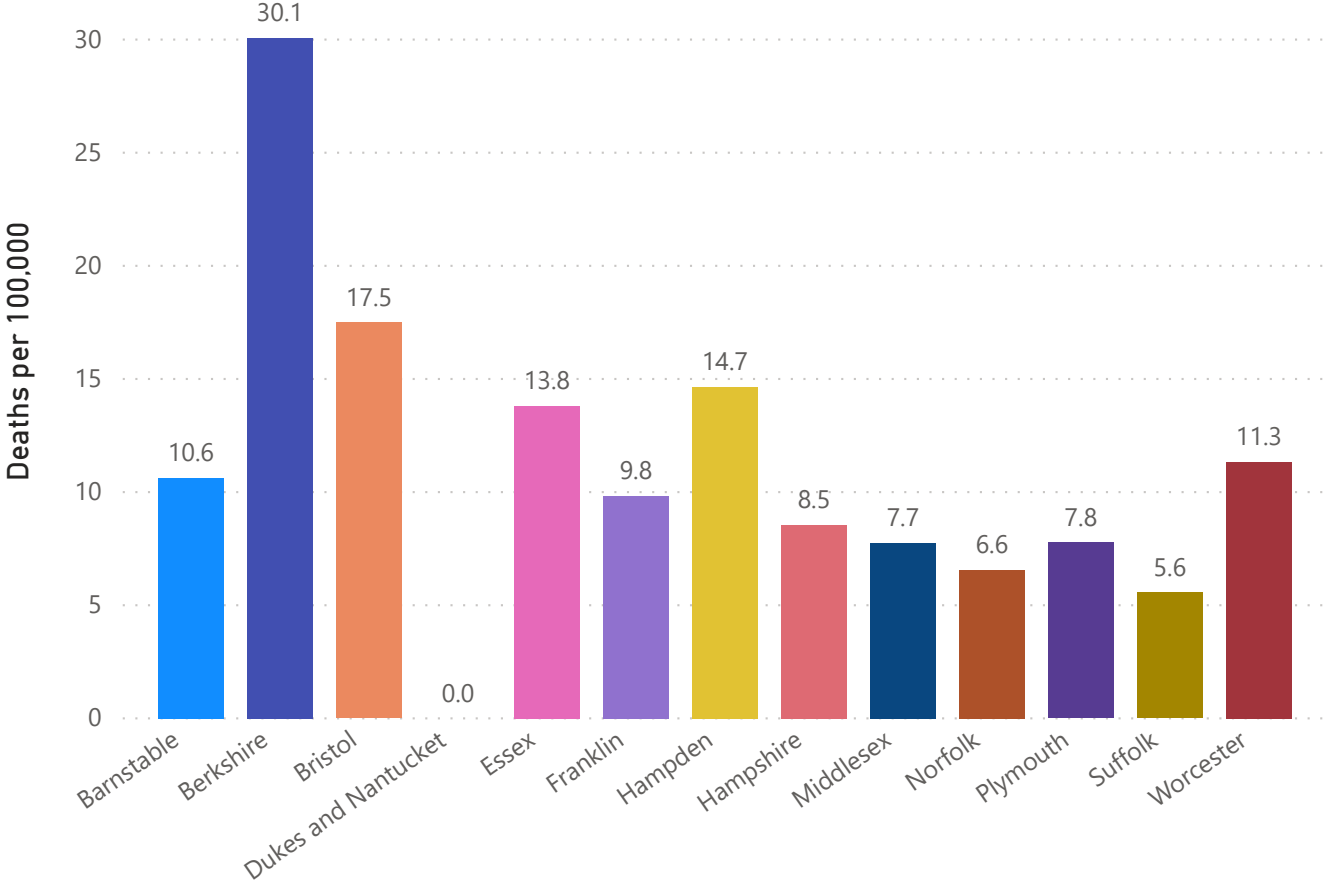
Deaths and Death Rate by County for Last Two Weeks

Rate (per 100,000) of Total COVID-19 Deaths by County



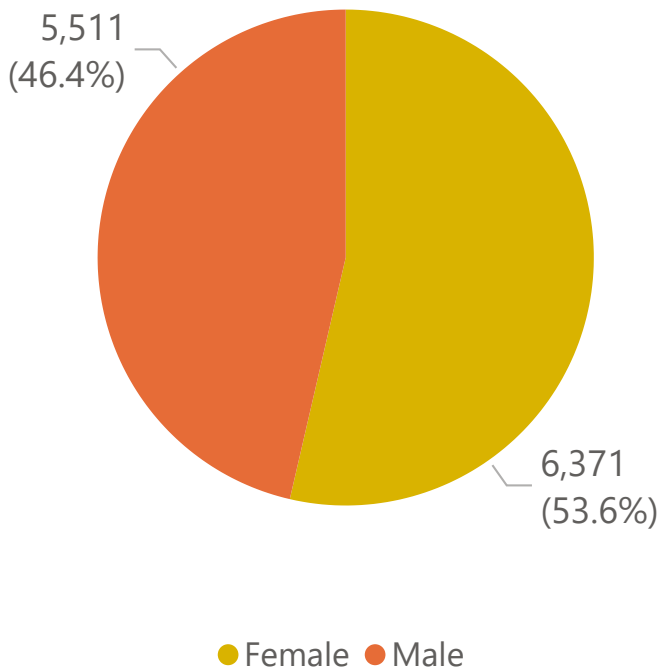

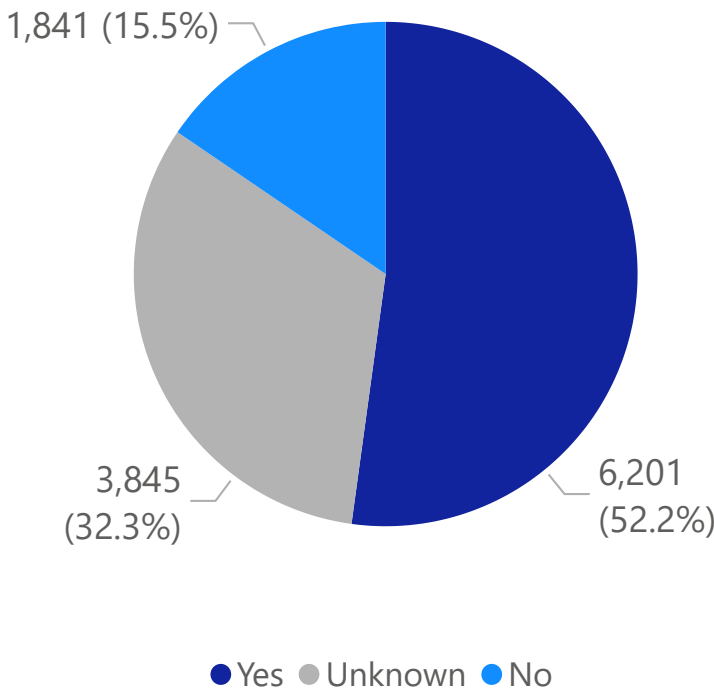
Deaths by Sex, Previous Hospitalization, & Underlying Conditions

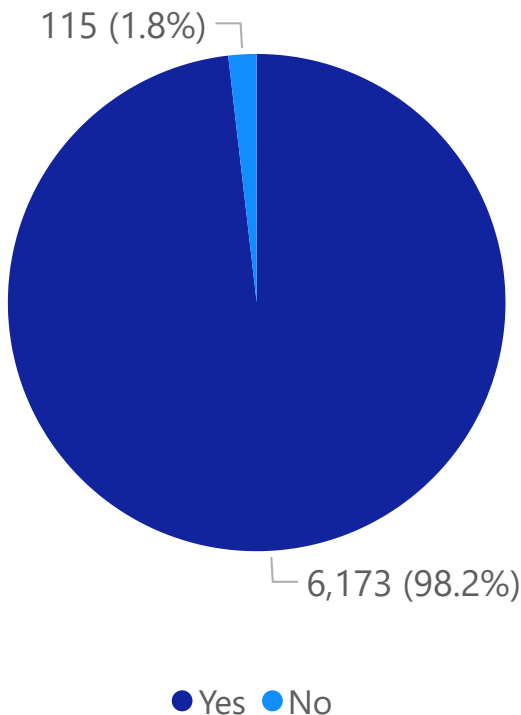
Total Deaths by Sex+

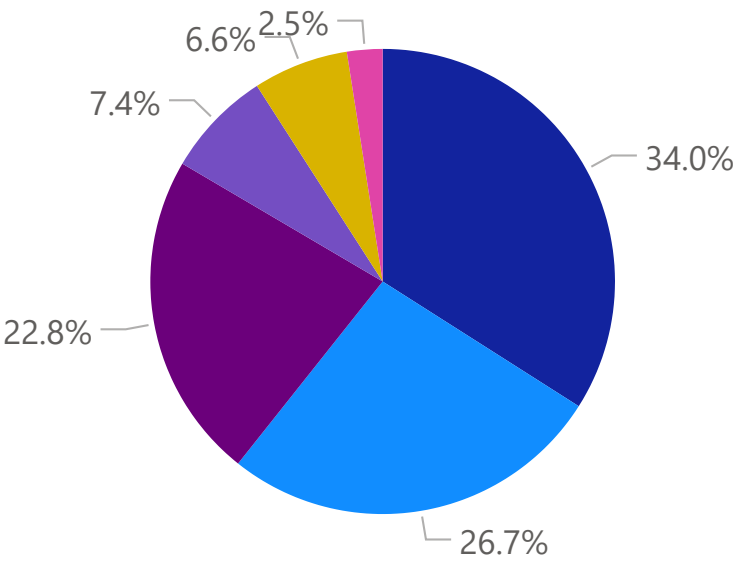

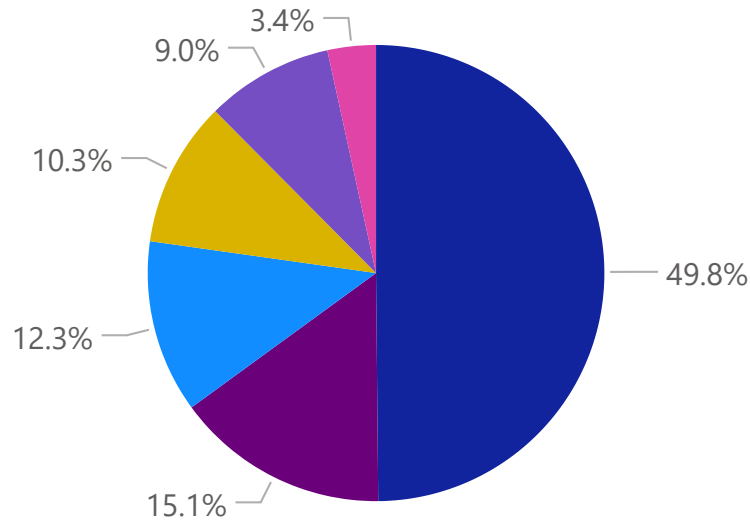

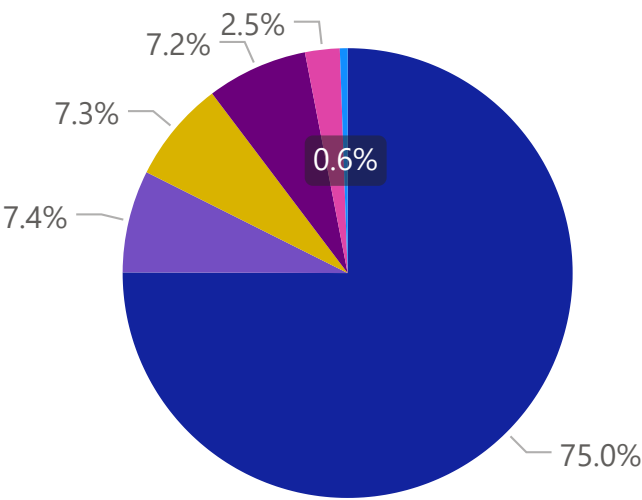

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Long-Term Care Staff Surveillance Testing

- On June 30, the Commonwealth issued an evidence-based surveillance testing policy for long-term care facilities to further support the safe care of vulnerable residents in these settings. This [testing policy](#) has been updated to align with federal policy and as more is learned about COVID-19
- **Nursing facilities and rest homes are required to comply with the surveillance testing regimen, and may be subject to financial sanctions for non-compliance**
- Nursing facilities and rest homes were required to perform baseline testing of at least 90% of staff by July 19
- Facilities are required to conduct surveillance testing of all staff on a weekly basis
- This report includes information on the percentage of staff tested at each facility from the latest complete testing period, and whether a facility was in compliance with state requirements
- The state is supporting surveillance testing costs for nursing facilities and rest homes

Infection Control Surveys

DPH serves as the State Survey Agency (SA) that submits COVID-19 nursing home data on behalf of Massachusetts to the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS). As outlined in the [June 1st CMS memorandum](#) CMS updated its COVID-19 reporting requirements to ensure 100% of Medicare- and Medicaid-certified nursing homes receive on-site review to mitigate the spread of COVID-19. Reporting requirements apply *only* to Medicare- and Medicaid-certified nursing homes, not *all* facilities in the state.

Multiple Surveys Explained: CMS requires states perform COVID-19 survey activities in addition to completing the required Focused Infection Control surveys of 100% of Medicare- and Medicaid-certified nursing homes by July 31, 2020. Additionally, CMS requires states perform on-site infection control surveys within three-to-five days of identification of any nursing home with three or more new COVID-19 suspected and confirmed cases since their last National Healthcare Safety Network (NHSN) COVID-19 report or any nursing home in which one confirmed resident case is present in a facility that was previously COVID-free. As facilities may require a number of on-site infection control surveys, we show here the results of the five most recent surveys.

Deficiencies Explained:

- The **severity** level reflects the impact of the deficiency and is categorized by four levels of harm.
- The **scope** level of a deficiency reflects how many residents were affected by the deficiency.
- For each deficiency, the DPH survey team determines the level of harm (**severity**) to the resident or resident(s) involved and then determines the **scope** of the problem within the nursing home.
- The team assigns an alphabetical Severity and Scope value to the deficiency. In the report below, the alphabetical values are A through L. Values closer to A signify lower scope and severity. Values closer to L (i.e. G or higher) signify higher scope and severity.
- The key at the bottom of each page indicates the level of deficiencies reported, which corresponds to dots of different colors:
Green = Deficiency-free survey; **Yellow** = D-level deficiency; **Pink** = E/F-level deficiency; **Red** = G or higher

372 facilities received a combined total of 1,286 Infection Control Surveys between June 1 and December 4.
Between November 30-December 4, 2020, 80 new surveys were mailed to facilities. Of those 80 new surveys:

CMS Infection Control Surveys Conducted at Nursing Homes

The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) requires infection control surveys to be conducted at all Medicare- and Medicaid-certified nursing homes as defined in the following link:
<https://www.cms.gov/files/document/qso-20-31-all.pdf>. DPH conducts these surveys on behalf of CMS.

Some facilities that meet certain CMS requirements have been surveyed more than once. Follow-up infection control surveys must be conducted within three-to-five days when: (1) one confirmed COVID-19 case is reported in a nursing home that previously did not have any COVID-19 cases, and (2) three or more new suspected and confirmed cases are reported in nursing homes in one week that had previously reported a case.
