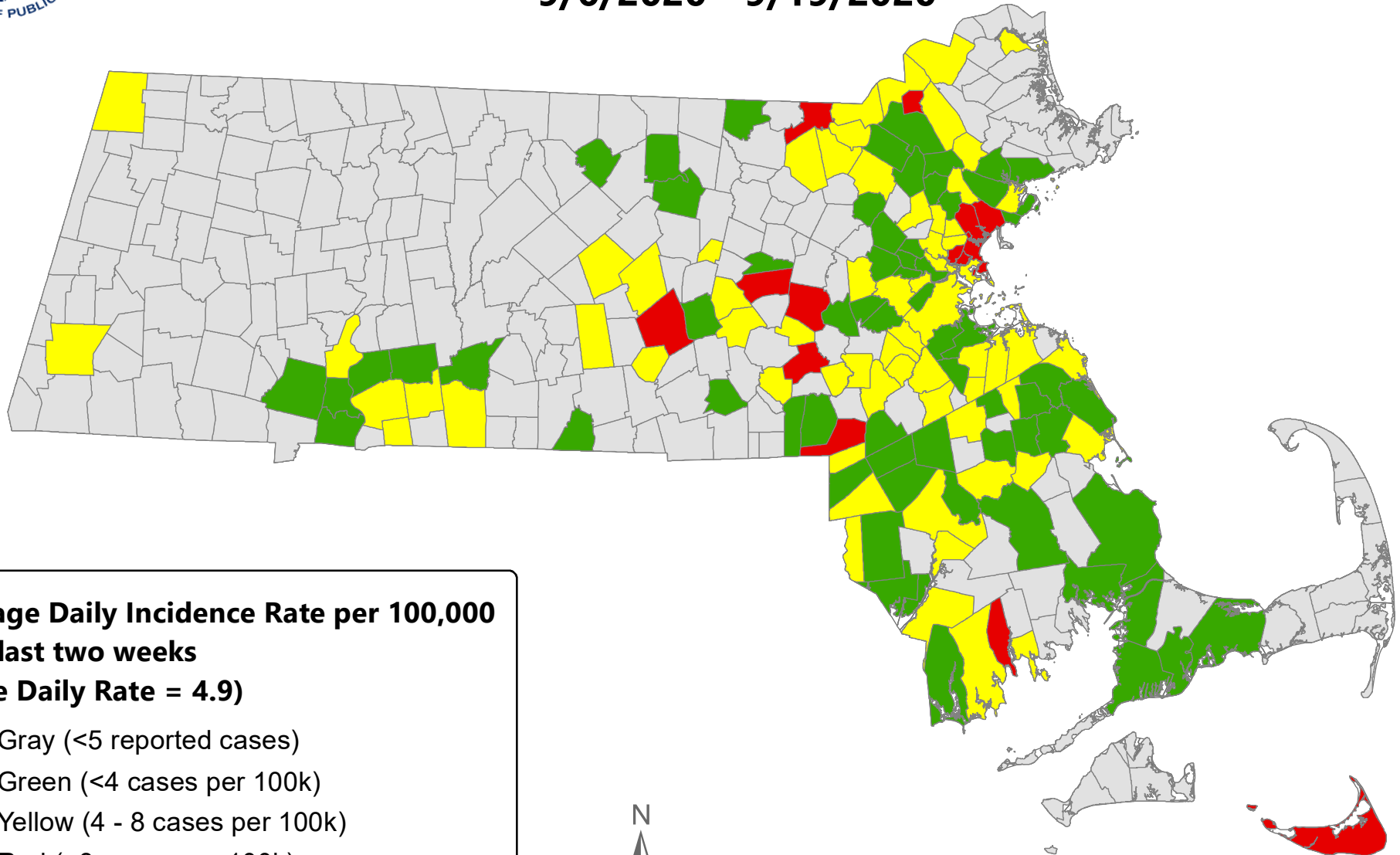

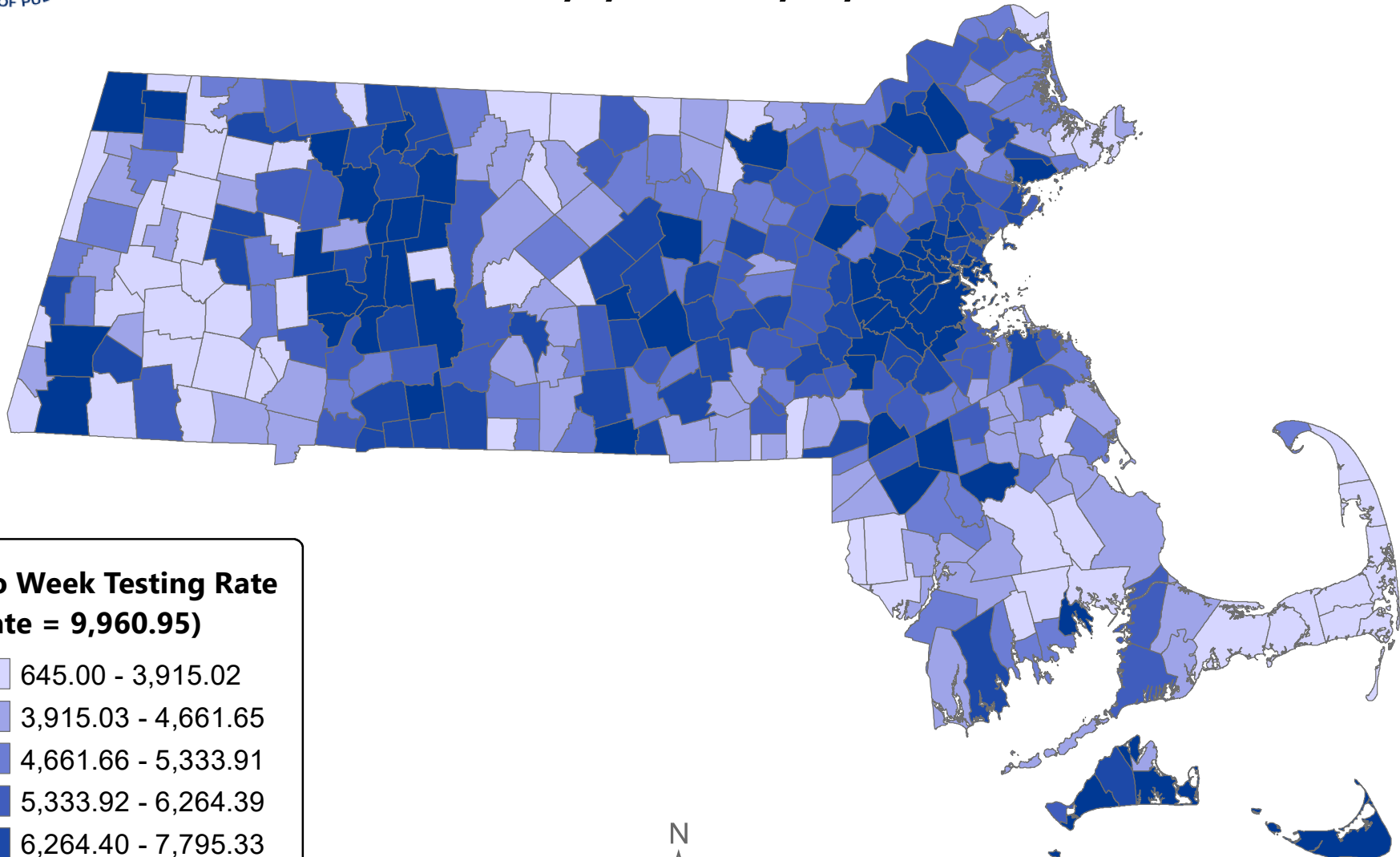

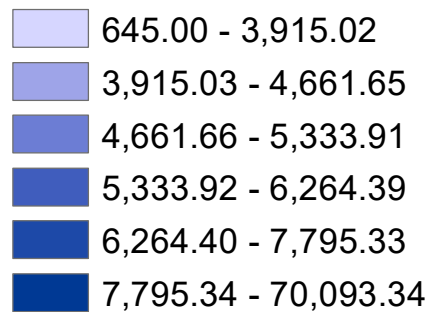

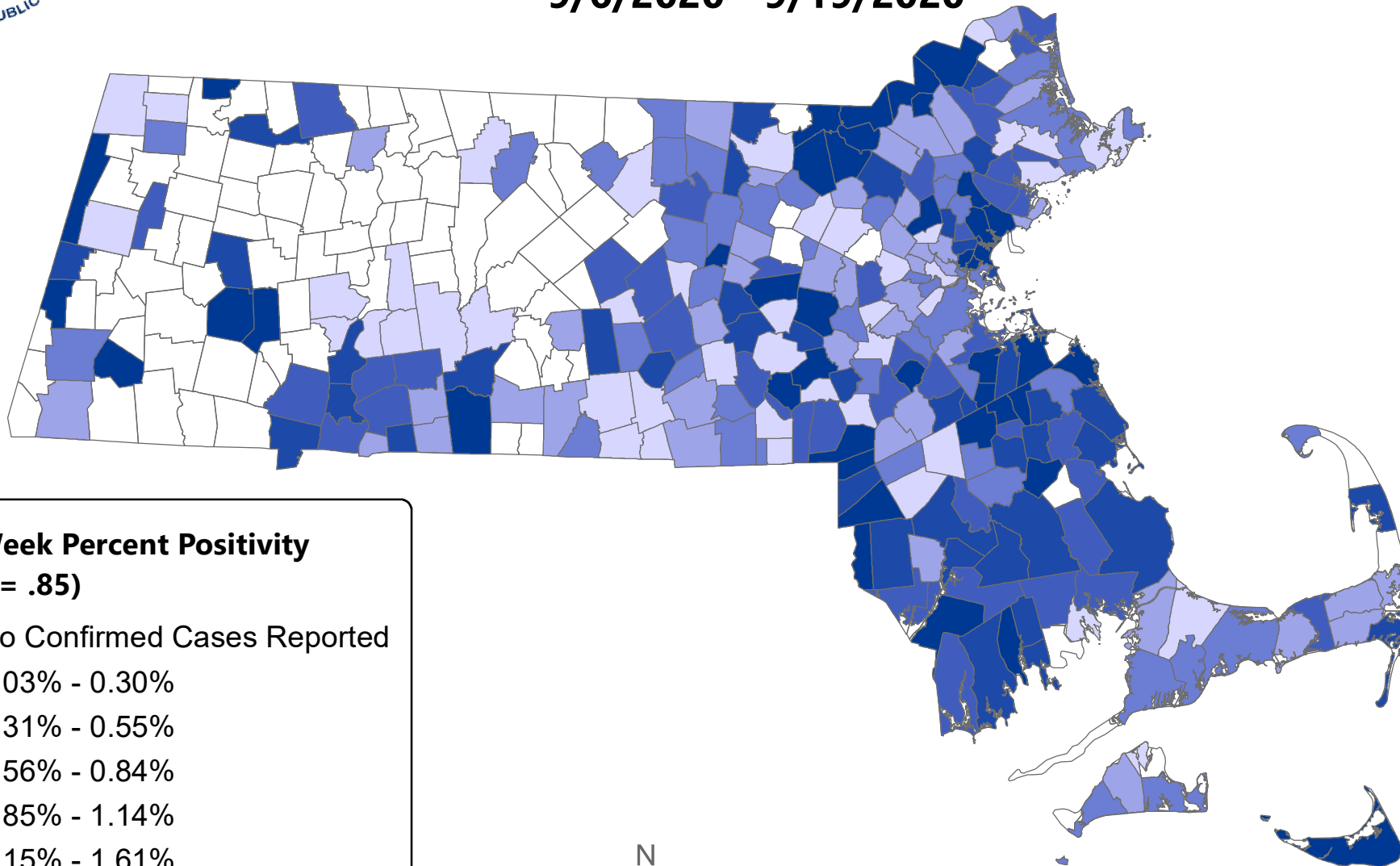

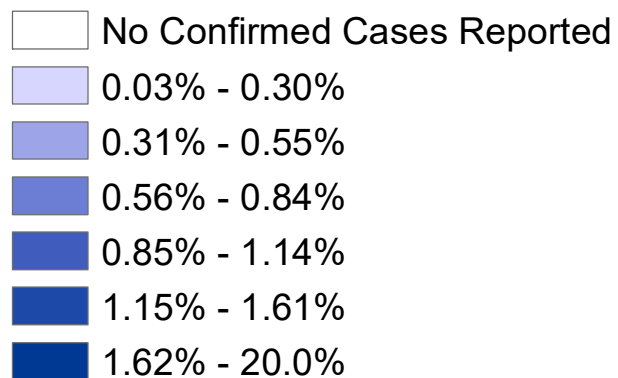

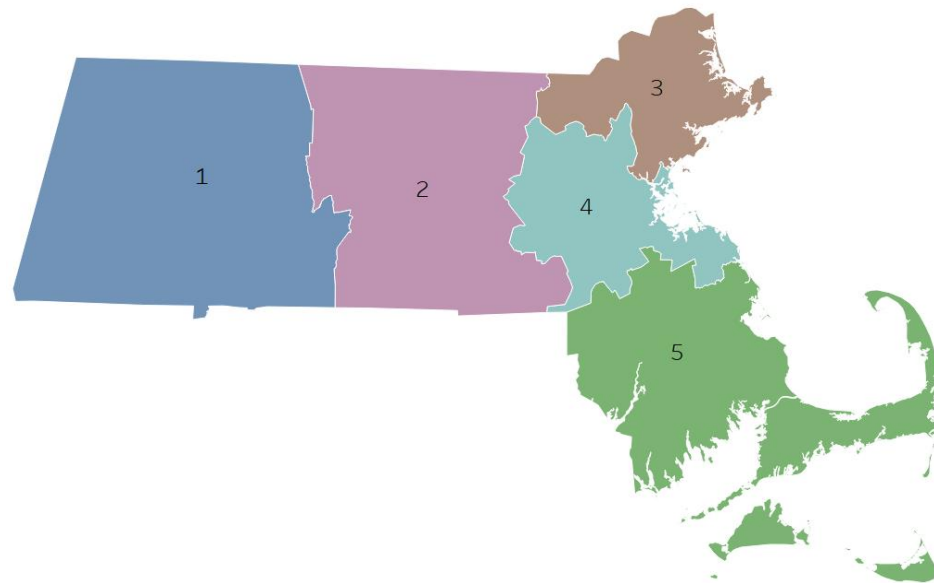

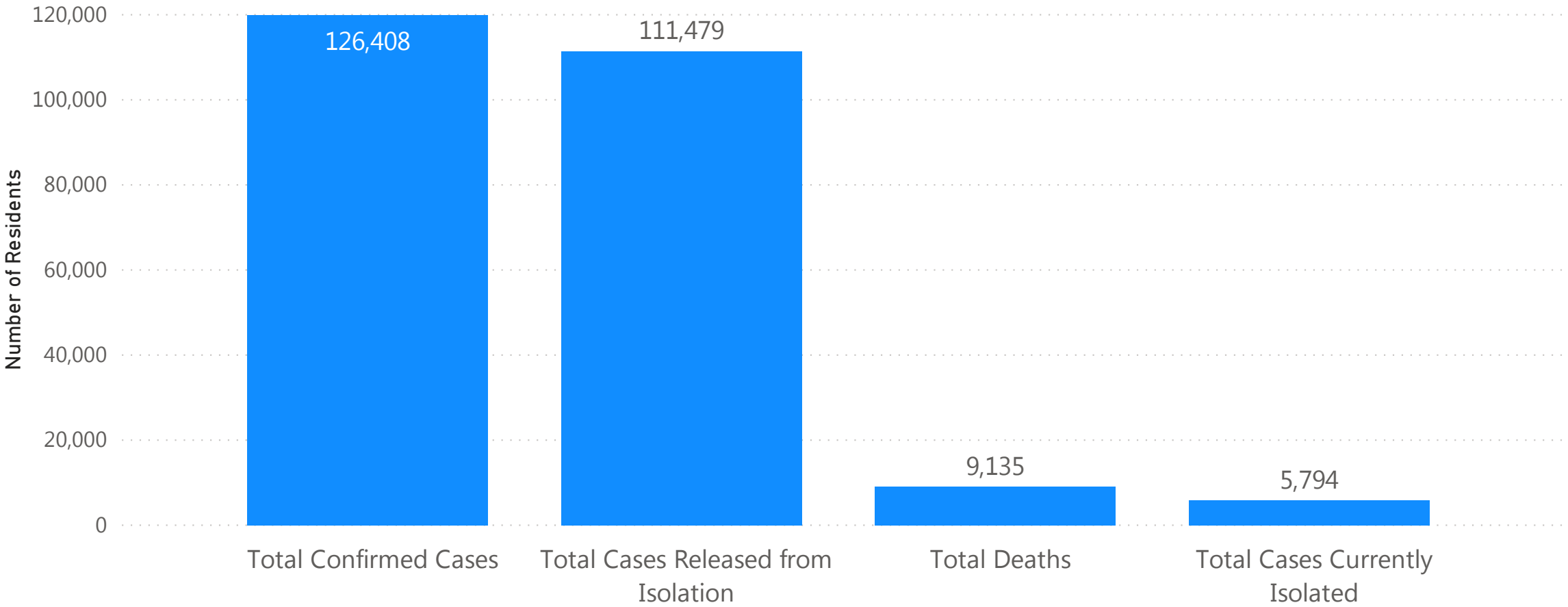

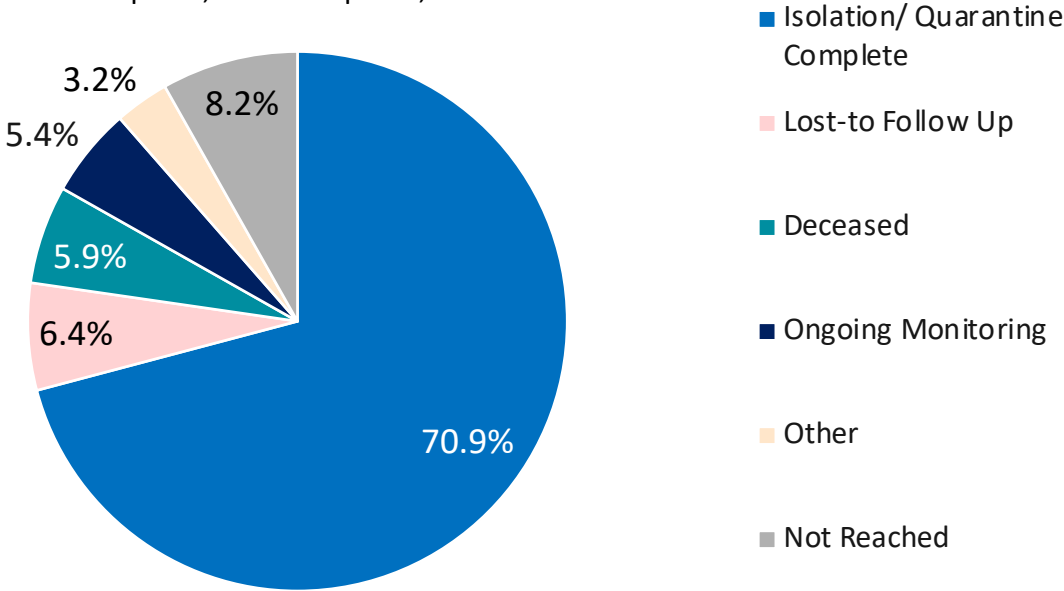

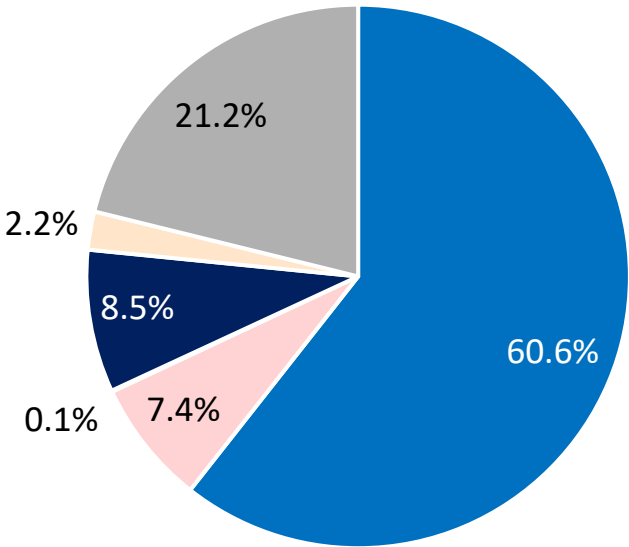

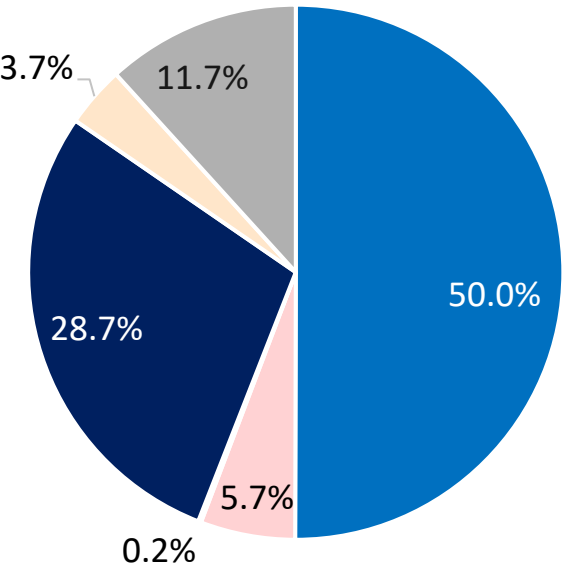

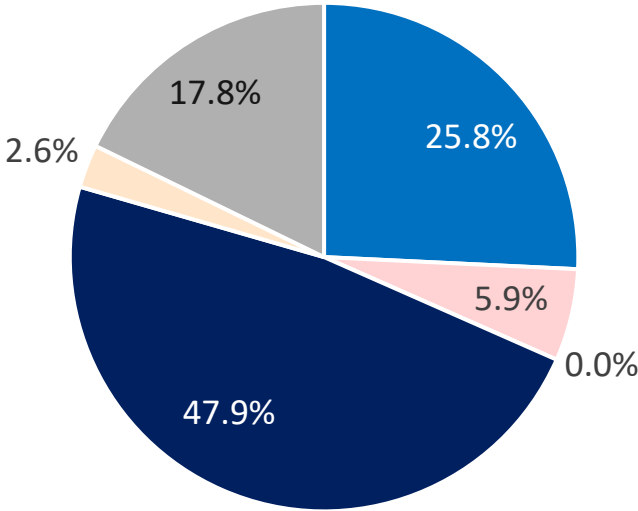

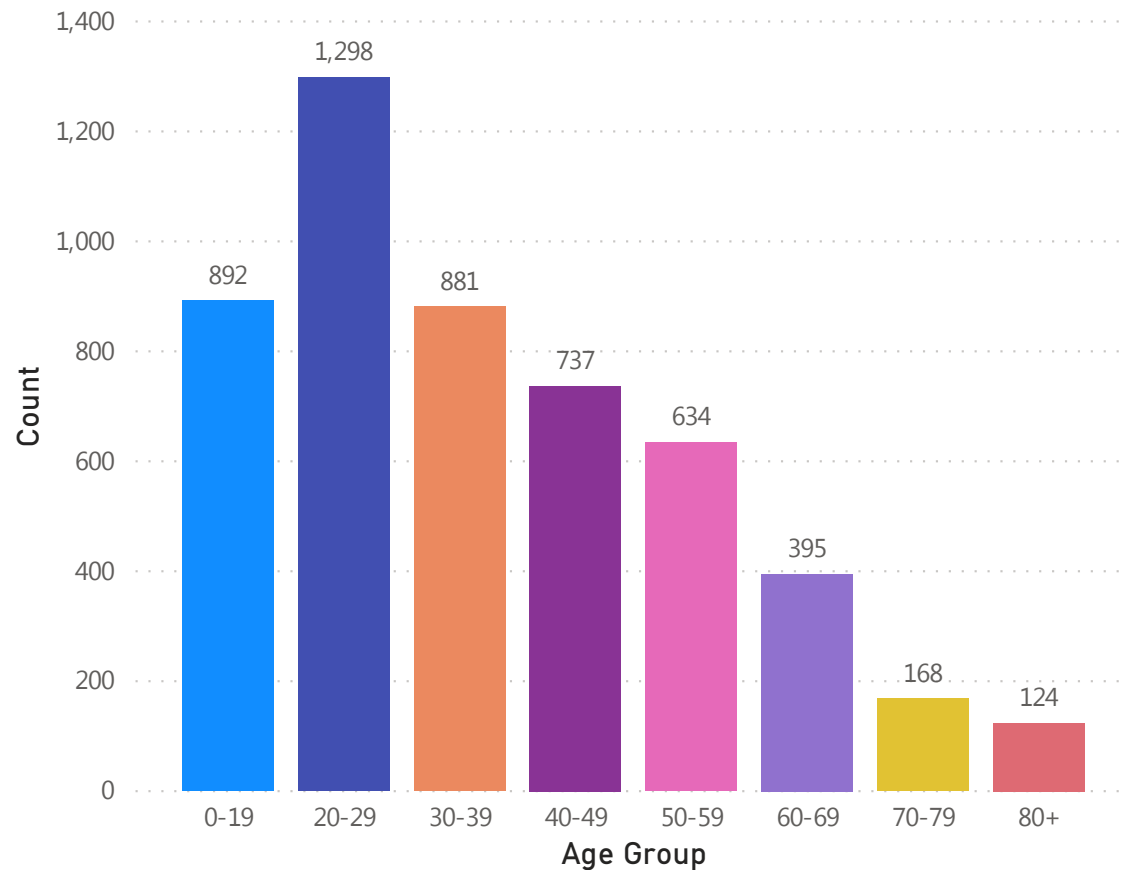

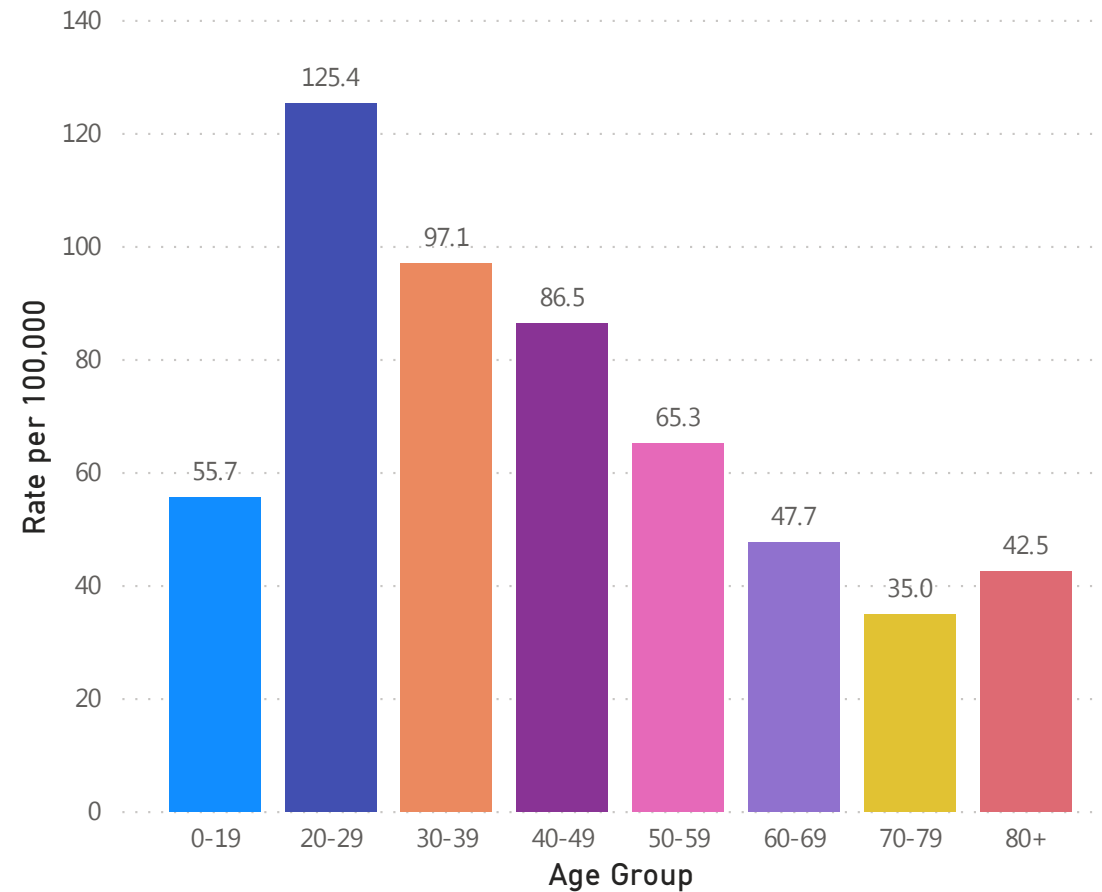
Cases and Case Rate by Age Group for Last Two Weeks

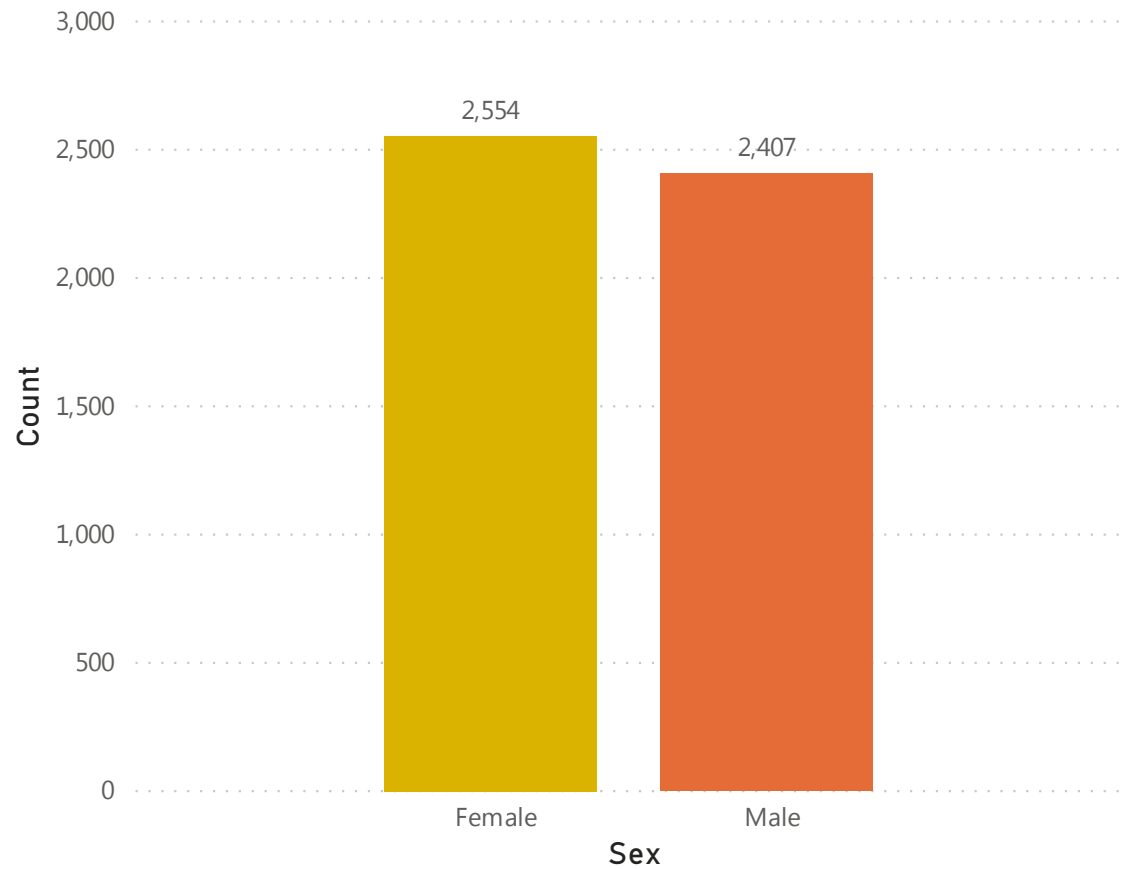

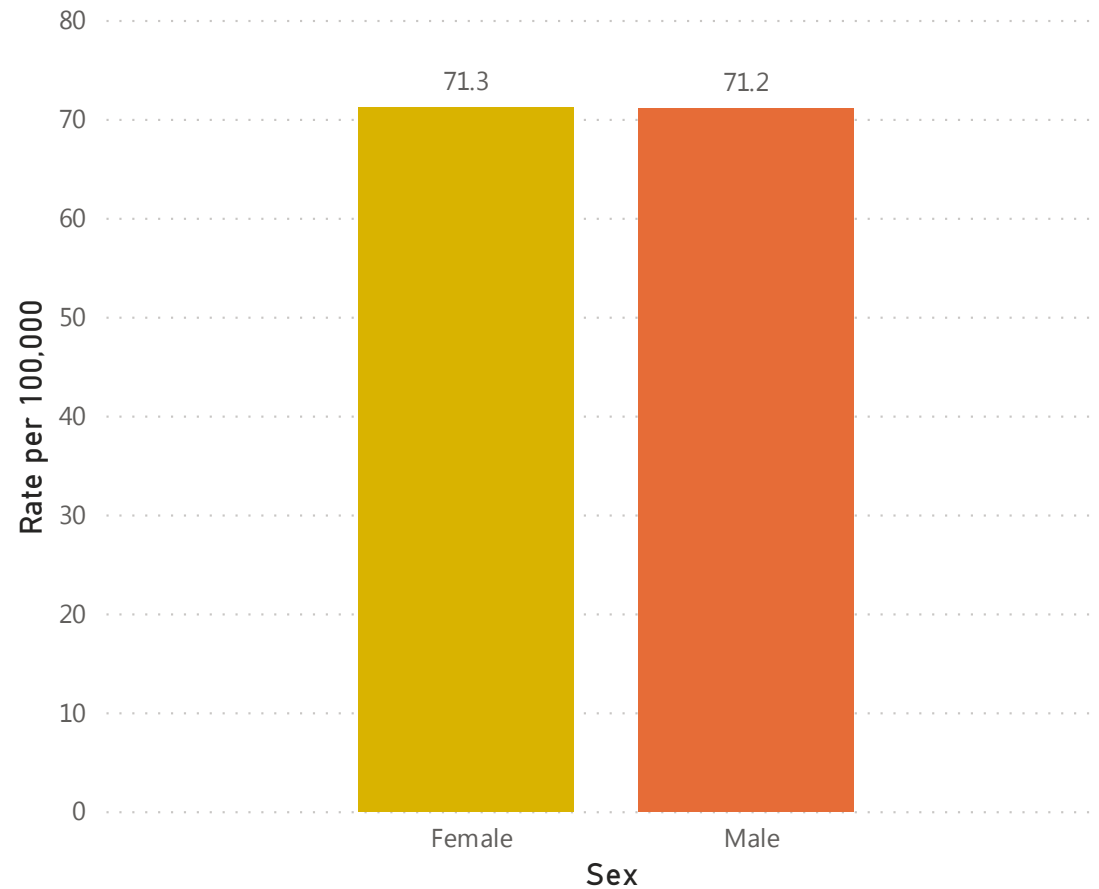

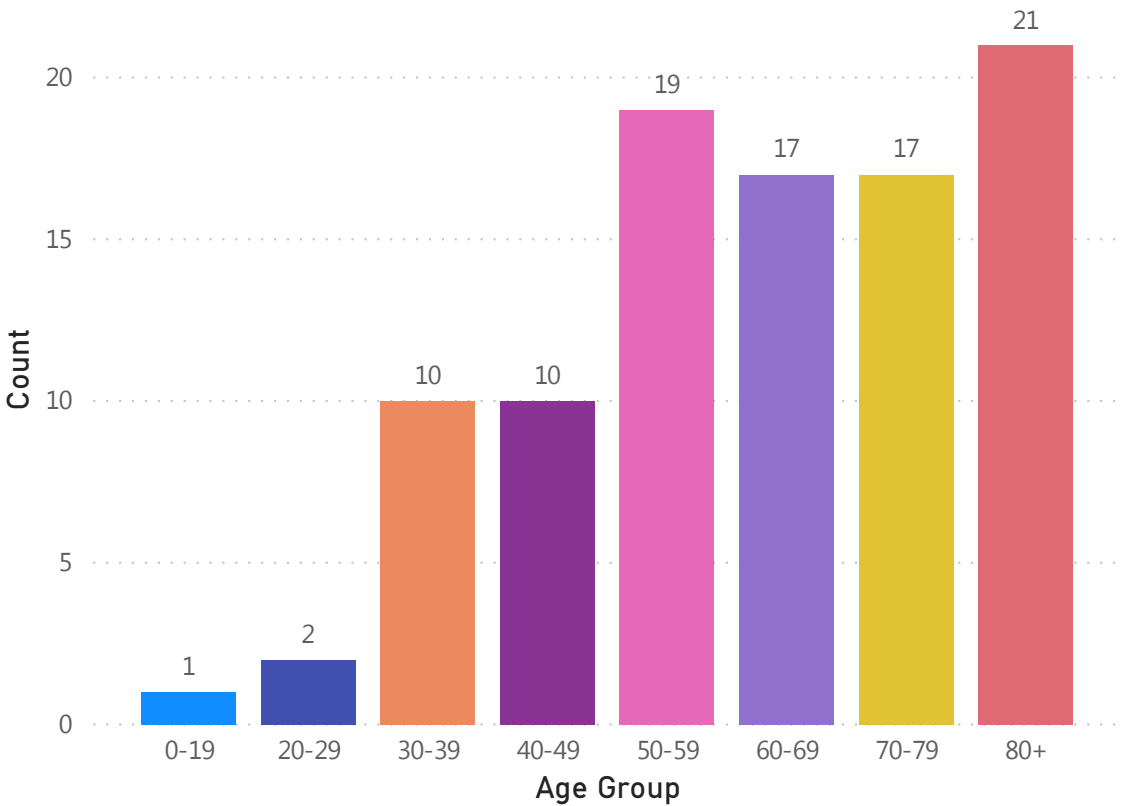


Hospitalizations & Hospitalization Rate by Age Group

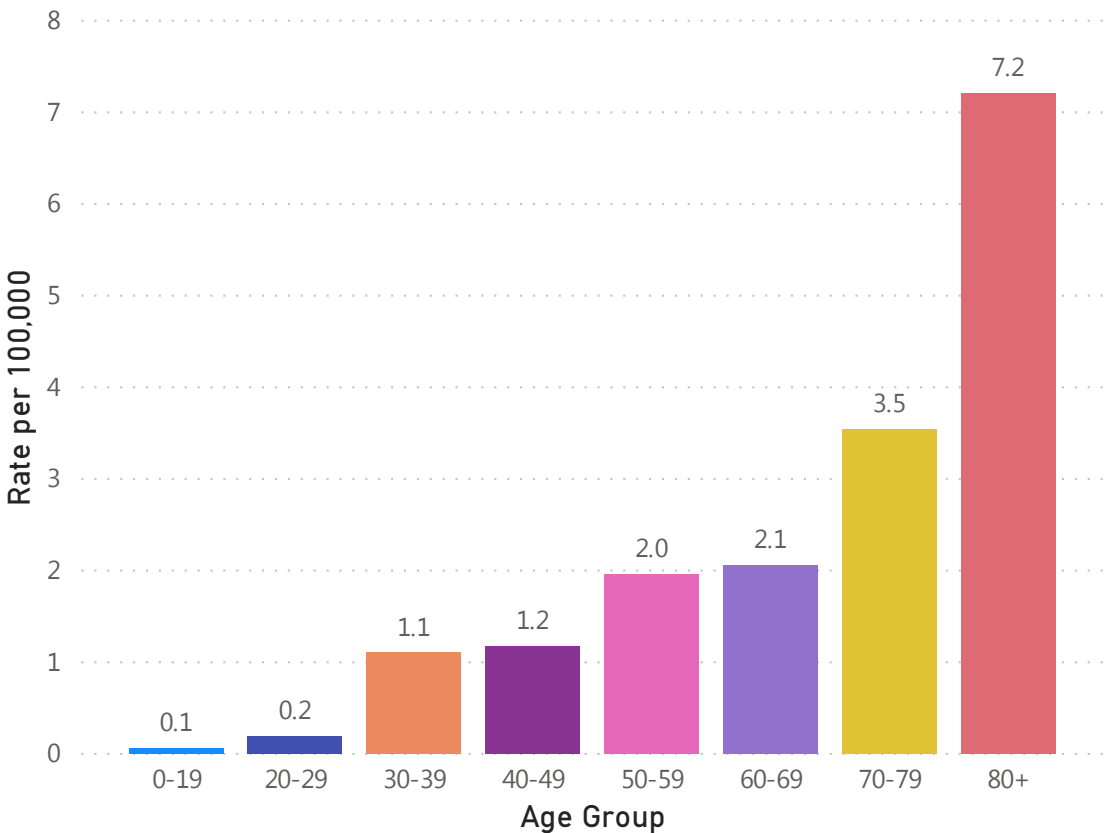

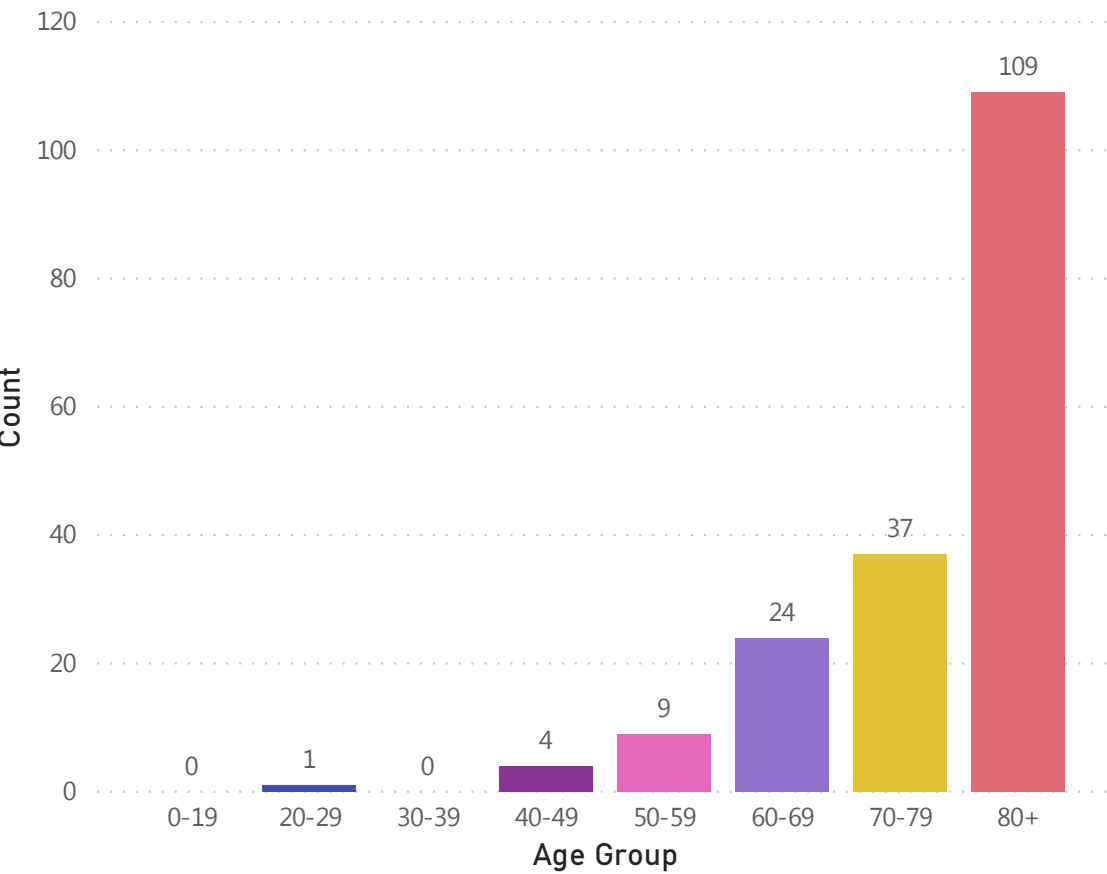

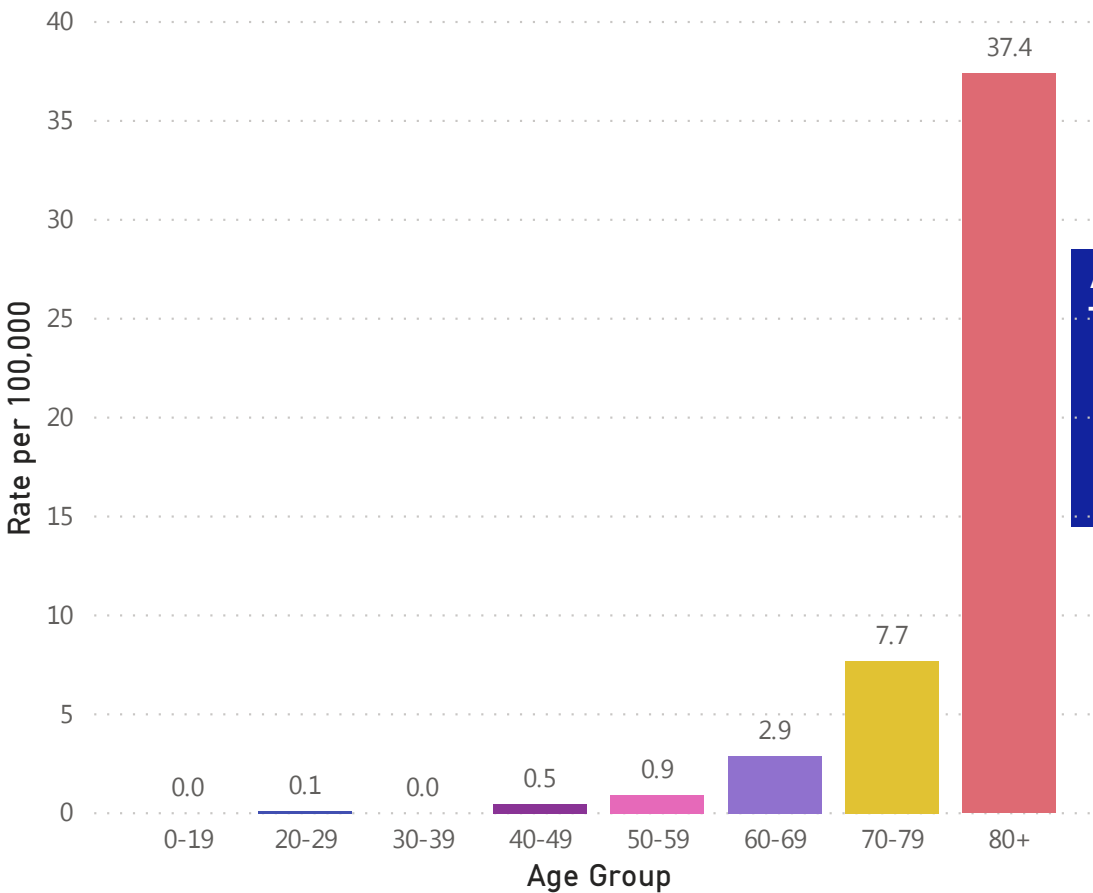
Deaths and Death Rate by Age Group for Last Two Weeks

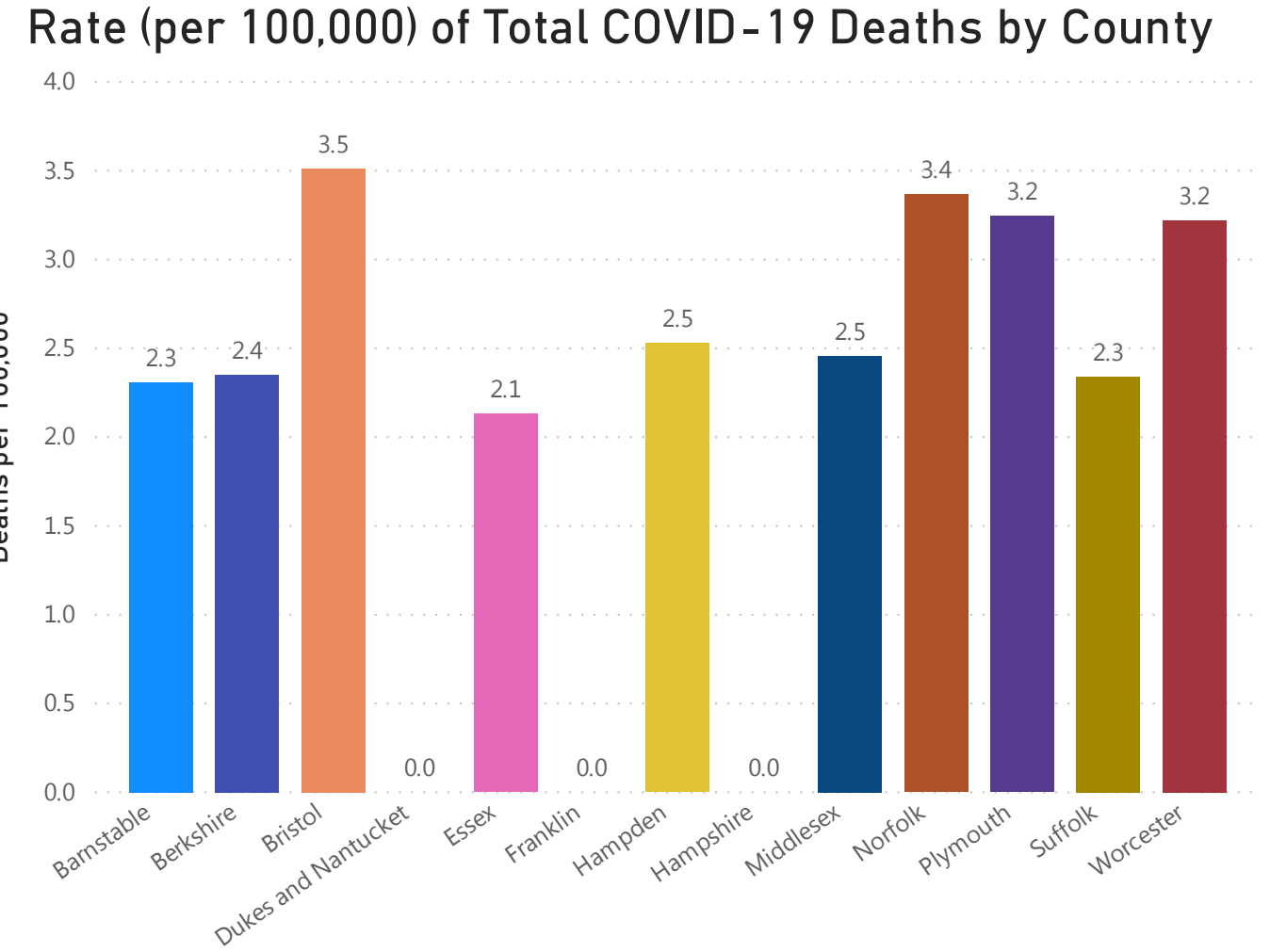

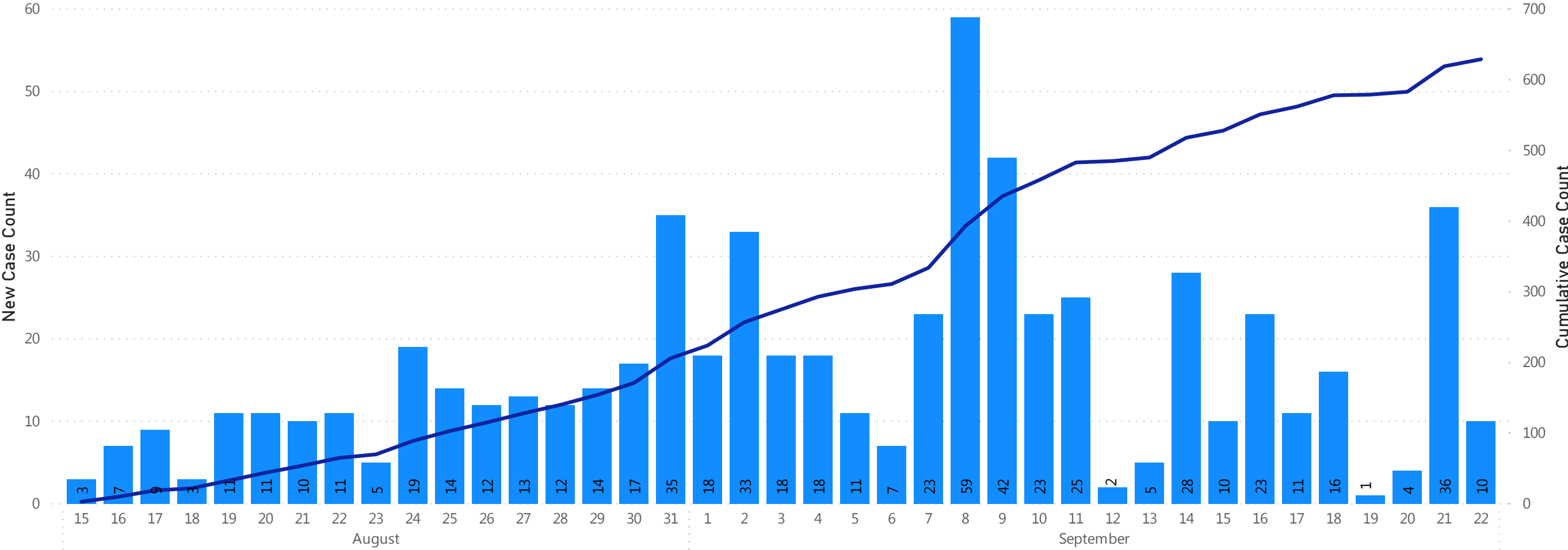

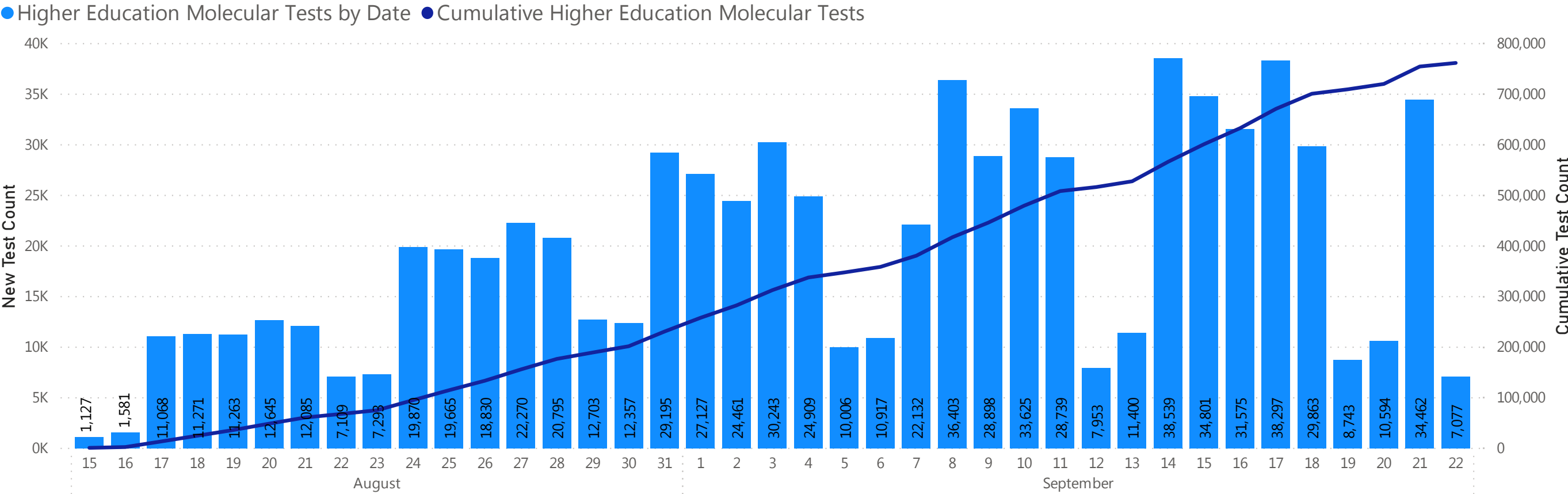

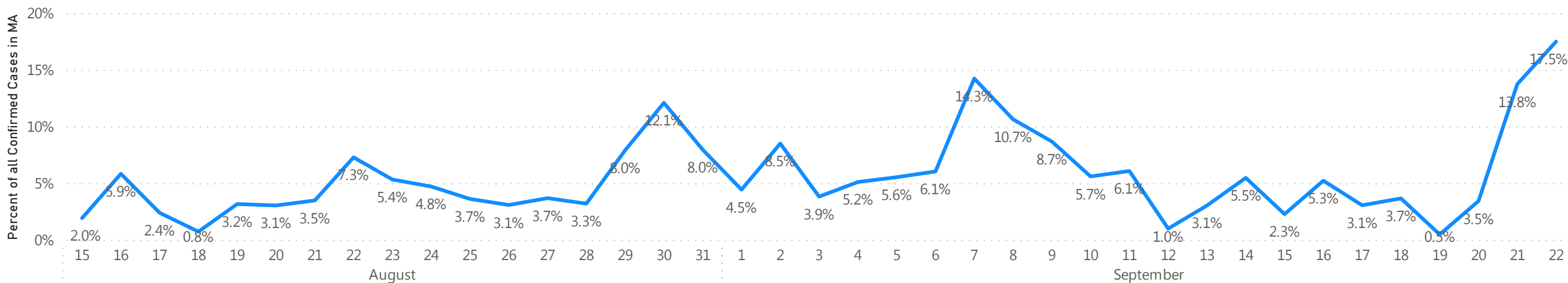

Long-Term Care Staff Surveillance Testing

- On June 30, the Commonwealth issued an evidence-based surveillance testing policy for long-term care facilities to further support the safe care of vulnerable residents in these settings
- Nursing facilities and rest homes are required to comply with the surveillance testing regimen, and may be subject to financial sanctions for non-compliance**
- To determine the cadence of surveillance testing, nursing facilities and rest homes were required to perform baseline testing of at least 90% of staff by July 19
- Facilities are required to adhere to a surveillance testing regimen based on the results of the baseline testing and adapt such regimen based on the presence of new cases and regional transmission rates; specifically:
 - If there are new COVID+ cases, the facility must test all staff weekly until there are no new cases for two weeks**
 - If there are no new COVID+ cases, the facility must either test all staff, or 30% of staff, bi-weekly, depending on the transmission rates in the facility’s EMS region (included in this report)**
- This report includes information on what staff surveillance testing regimen each facility is required to adhere to, and the percentage of staff tested during the latest complete testing period

Infection Control Surveys

DPH serves as the State Survey Agency (SA) that submits COVID-19 nursing home data on behalf of Massachusetts to the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS). As outlined in the [June 1st CMS memorandum](#) CMS updated its COVID-19 reporting requirements to ensure 100% of Medicare- and Medicaid-certified nursing homes receive on-site review to mitigate the spread of COVID-19. Reporting requirements apply *only* to Medicare- and Medicaid-certified nursing homes, not *all* facilities in the state.

Multiple Surveys Explained: CMS requires states perform COVID-19 survey activities in addition to completing the required Focused Infection Control surveys of 100% of Medicare- and Medicaid-certified nursing homes by July 31, 2020. In addition, CMS requires states perform on-site infection control surveys within three-to-five days of identification of any nursing home with three or more new COVID-19 suspected and confirmed cases since their last National Healthcare Safety Network (NHSN) COVID-19 report or any nursing home in which one confirmed resident case is present in a facility that was previously COVID-free.

Deficiencies Explained:

- The **severity** level reflects the impact of the deficiency and is categorized by four levels of harm.
- The **scope** level of a deficiency reflects how many residents were affected by the deficiency.
- For each deficiency, the DPH survey team determines the level of harm (**severity**) to the resident or resident(s) involved and then determines the **scope** of the problem within the nursing home.
- The team assigns an alphabetical Severity and Scope value to the deficiency. In the report below, the alphabetical values are A through L. Values closer to A signify lower scope and severity. Values closer to L (i.e. G or higher) signify higher scope and severity.
- The key at the bottom of each page indicates the level of deficiencies reported, which corresponds to dots of different colors: **Green** = Deficiency-free survey; **Yellow** = D-level deficiency; **Pink** = E/F-level deficiency; **Red** = G or higher

372 facilities received a combined total of 767 Infection Control Surveys between June 1 and September 4.
Between August 29-September 4, 2020, 60 new surveys were mailed to facilities. Of those 60 new surveys:

The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) requires infection control surveys to be conducted at all Medicare- and Medicaid-certified nursing homes as defined in the following link:
<https://www.cms.gov/files/document/qso-20-31-all.pdf>. DPH conducts these surveys on behalf of CMS.

Some facilities that meet certain CMS requirements have been surveyed more than once. Follow-up infection control surveys must be conducted within three-to-five days when: (1) one confirmed COVID-19 case is reported in a nursing home that previously did not have any COVID-19 cases, and (2) three or more new suspected and confirmed cases are reported in nursing homes in one week that had previously reported a case.
