West Boylston Package Store Co. (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, September 3, 2013, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an Illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: c. 138 §34 Sale or Delivery of an Alcoholic Beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Bailey's Report.

## FACTS

- 1. On Monday, June 3, 2013, at approximately 6:34 p.m., Investigators Bailey and Doyle conducted an investigation of the business operation of West Boylston Package Store Co.
- 2. An underage operative working with investigators purchased an alcoholic beverage, a 24 ounce can of Budweiser Light beer, for two dollars (\$2.00). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

As the licensee has been in business for more than sixty (60) years and has had no previous violations, the Commission issues a **WARNING**.
