## **Project Location**



#### **Project Limits**

- Memorial Avenue corridor from Colony Road/Big E Gate 1 intersection to terminus between the Main Street intersection and Route 5 rotary
- Roadways affected:
  - Baldwin Street
  - Bridge Street
  - Union Street
  - Bresnahan Street
  - Main Street
  - Minor work along side streets

#### **Total Project Length**

1.5 Miles



### Purpose and Need



#### **Project Goals**


- Improve intersection safety and operations
- Provide safe and continuous pedestrian, bicycle, and ADA accommodations
- Calm traffic along corridor
- Improve transit facilities
- Maintain access to all businesses and abutters
- Integrate the neighborhoods through the construction of safe and improved facilities
- Reconstruct the pavement; Improve drainage and sewer systems



#### Lattitude (Restaurant) & Big E Entrance

#### **Existing Issues Affecting Safety:**

- Excessive crosswalk length
- Wide lanes encourage high speeds
- Lack of bicycle accommodations
- Pedestrian fatality on March 23, 2012





#### **Bridge Street Intersection**

#### **Existing Issues Affecting Safety:**

- Memorial Avenue curve requires realignment
- Wide lanes encourage higher speeds
- Rollover fatality occurred on September 23, 2021
- Sidewalks in poor condition
- Lack of bicycle accommodations






#### **Union Street Intersection**



#### **Existing Issues Affecting Safety:**

- Outdated equipment and the overall operation of intersection
- Faded striping
- Non-ADA compliant ramps
- Lack of bicycle accommodations



#### **Existing Issues Affecting Safety:**

- Sidewalks in poor condition
- Lack of ADA pedestrian curb ramps
- Lack of bicycle accommodations
- Unsafe transit stop
  - No turnout or shelter



#### **Main Street Intersection**

#### **Existing Issues Affecting Safety:**

- Wide lanes encourage higher speeds
- Pedestrian fatality occurred nearby on October 28, 2019
- Excessive crosswalk length
- Lack of bicycle accommodations

### Construction Scope

#### **Proposed Improvements**:

- Overall Improvements
  - Reconstruct remaining 4-lane section with new medians (flush and raised)
  - Continuous cement concrete sidewalks & new ADA ramps
  - Updated transit facilities
  - Reconstruct CSX railroad crossing with gates
  - Drainage, sewer, and water improvements
- Gate 1 & Circuit Avenue
  - Three-lane section (from four lanes)
  - 8' wide two-way separated bike lane
  - Signalized "HAWK" crosswalk
- Lattitude & Big E Entrance
  - Signalized RRFB crosswalk



- Memorial Avenue
  - Provide 5' shoulders/buffered bike lanes along both sides
  - Realign curve at Bridge Street
  - Reconstruct pavement
- Bridge Street
  - Reconfigure intersection
- Bresnahan St & Main Street/Century Way
  - Reconfigure the intersections
- Baldwin Street, Union Street & Bresnahan Street
  - Reconstruct signalized intersections



### Lattitude / Big E Gate:

- Three-lane section
- Two 11' lanes
- Center left-turn lane
- Variable width shoulders
- Two sidewalks
- 8' two-way separated bike lane
- Landscape buffers where feasible
- Maintain on-street parking for local businesses
- Bus turnouts
- RRFB signalized crosswalks






#### **Memorial Ave**

(Looking East at Norman St)

- Three-lane section
- Two-way separated bike lane and sidewalks
- Landscape strip
  - Separates curb and sidewalk on north side
  - Located between curb and two-way separated bike lane





#### Bridge St / Union St:

- Typical 4-lane section
- Four 11' travel lanes
- Left-turn lanes at intersection
- Two 5' buffered bike lanes
- Two sidewalks
- Landscape buffers
- Raised and flush medians
- Bus turnouts
- Signal reconstruction at Union St
- Two-stage bike boxes






#### **Memorial Ave**

(Looking East at Bresnahan St)


- Four lane section
- Raised median
- Buffered bike lanes
- Landscape strip between curb and sidewalk





# Memorial Ave / Bresnahan St / Main St:

- Memorial Ave
  - Four 11' through/through right lanes
  - Left turn lanes at intersection
  - Two 5' buffered bike lanes
  - Two sidewalks
  - Landscape buffers
  - Medians
  - Bus turnouts
  - Signal reconstruction at Bresnahan St
  - Two-stage bike boxes
- Bresnahan St
  - Reopen to NB traffic from Memorial Ave
  - Sidewalks connect neighborhoods
  - Parking for businesses on easterly side
- Main St
  - Remove cut through NB access from Memorial Ave to Bresnahan St
  - Allow access to Century Way from WB
  - Additional Parking
  - Green space (pocket park) at intersection with Bresnahan



### **Construction Impacts**



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- Off-peak hours
  - Paving and roadway reconstruction
  - Drainage and utility work
  - Lane closures and/or alternating traffic may be needed
- Regular construction hours
  - Roadside work
- Night work will be allowed
  - Prohibited within 500' of residential dwellings, except for specific water main work detailed on the plans as required to be performed at night
- Work hour restrictions will limit impacts to businesses and abutters
- Driveway and pedestrian access will be maintained
- Pavement Reclamation 12 Mobilizations/Demobilizations Anticipated

### Procurement



- Project was advertised June 4, 2022
- Engineer's estimate was \$19,833,755.00
- Bid opening was July 19, 2022
- Three (3) bids were received:
