## DECISION

EVVIVA CUCINA LLC 7 CORNERSTONE SQ WESTFORD, MA 01886 LICENSE#: 144200056

VIOLATION DATE: 03/12/2014

HEARD: 06/24/2014

Evviva Cucina LLC (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, June 24, 2014, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) - Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: c. 138, §34 Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Bailey's Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

- 1. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts; and
- 2. Investigator Bailey's Investigative Report dated March 12, 2014.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

## **FACTS**

- 1. On Wednesday, March 12, 2014 at approximately 6:28 p.m., Investigators Doyle and Bailey conducted an investigation of the business operation of Evviva Cucina LLC.
- 2. An underage operative, working with investigators, was in possession of a can of Budweiser beer. The underage operative was not asked for identification.

## CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) – Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: c. 138, §34 – Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Therefore, the Commission suspends the license for three (3) days of which three (3) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.
