Albert E. Lees, Inc. dba Lees Supermarket (the "Licensee") holds an all alcohol license issued pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws chapter 138, §15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, November 1, 2011, regarding an alleged violation of M.G.L. c. 138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Jamie Binienda's Compliance Check Field Report.

FACTS

- 1. On, July 27, 2011 at approximately 6:14 p.m., Commission Investigators investigated the business operation Albert E. Lees, Inc. dba Lees Supermarket.
- 2. An underage operative, working with the investigators, purchased a six (6) pack of Bud Light for six dollars and forty nine cents (\$6.49). The underage operative was not asked for identification.
- 3. Administrative review of the file indicates the license has no prior violations.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated M.G.L. c. 138, §34. Therefore, the Commission suspends the license for three (3) days of which three (3) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.
