## **DECISION**

HOUSE OF CHU, INC. DBA ORIENTAL PEARL RESTAURANT 576 STATE ROAD

House of Chu, Inc. dba Oriental Pearl Restaurant (the "Licensee") holds an all alcohol license issued pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws chapter 138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission ("the Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, October 25, 2011, regarding an alleged violation of M.G.L. c. 138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Jamie Binienda's Compliance Check Field Report.

1. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts; and

2. Compliance Check Field Report of Investigator Jamie Binienda.

## **FACTS**

- On, July 27, 2011 at approximately 6:45 p.m., Commission Investigators investigated the business operation House of Chu, Inc. dba Oriental Pearl Restaurant.
- 2. An underage operative, working with the investigators, purchased a can of Bud Light for four dollars and twenty five cents (\$4.25). The underage operative was not asked for identification.
- 3. Administrative review of the file indicates the license has no prior violations.

## CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated M.G.L. c. 138, §34. Therefore, the Commission suspends the license for three (3) days of which three (3) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.
