NOTICE OF SUSPENSION

After a hearing on June 3, 2025, the Commission finds BSFM Corp. d/b/a Bridge Street Food Mart violated M.G.L. Ch. 138, § 34 – Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age (1 count).

The Commission **suspends the license for a period of one (1) day to be served.**

The suspension shall be served on Monday, January 26, 2026. The license will be delivered to the Local Licensing Board or its designee on Monday, January 26, 2026, at 9:00 A.M. It will be returned to the licensee on January 27, 2026.

You are advised that pursuant to the provisions of M.G.L. c.138 § 23, you may petition the Commission to accept an offer in compromise in lieu of suspension within twenty (20) calendar days following such notice of such suspension. If accepted, you may pay a fine using the enclosed form which must be signed by the Licensee and a Massachusetts Licensed Accountant.

You are advised that you have the right to appeal this decision under M.G.L. c. 30A to Superior Court within thirty (30) days upon receipt of this notice.

DECISION

BSFM Corp. d/b/a Bridge Street Food Mart (“Licensee”) holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (“Commission” or “ABCC”) held a hearing on Tuesday, June 3, 2025, regarding an alleged violation of M.G.L. Ch. 138, § 34 Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age (1 count). Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the Licensee stipulated to the facts alleged in Investigator Velez’s Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Investigative Report of N. Velez;
2. Photograph of Fraudulent New York Driver’s License;
3. ABCC Licensing Authority Certification, Transfer of License Approved 4/16/2025;
4. Licensee Stipulation of Facts.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On Friday, April 25, 2025, at approximately 6:30 p.m. Investigators McDonough and Velez (“Investigators”) inspected the business operation of BSFM Corp. d/b/a Bridge Street Food Mart.
2. Investigators observed a youthful appearing male individual exit a gray Volkswagen Atlas SUV and enter the licensed premises. Minutes later, the same male exited the establishment with one 6-pack and one 30-pack of Bud Light beer. Investigators identified themselves and requested proof of legal age to purchase and/or possess alcoholic beverages.
3. Underage #1, actual date of birth 8/23/2006 (age 18), presented to Investigators a fraudulent New York driver’s license bearing his name but a different birth date. Underage #1 stated that he was not asked for any identification when he purchased the beer.


4. Investigators entered the licensed premises and spoke to the clerk on duty who admitted that he did not ask Underage #1 for any identification.
5. Investigators informed the clerk of the violation and that a report would be filed with the Chief Investigator for further review.
6. Tejas Patel, Licensee, appeared at the Commission hearing and testified he has since installed an identification scanner to assist with assessing identifications.
7. The Licensee has held a license under M.G.L. c. 138, § 15 since April 16, 2025.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the Licensee violated M.G.L. Ch. 138, § 34 Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age (1 Count). Therefore, the Commission **suspends the license for a period of one (1) day.**
