NOTICE OF SUSPENSION

November 13, 2025

After a hearing on July 29, 2025, the Commission finds BSFM Corp d/b/a Bridge Street Food Mart violated M.G.L. Ch. 138, § 34 Sale or Delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age (3 counts).

The Commission **SUSPENDS** the license for a period of five (5) days, of which three (3) days will be served and two (2) days will be held in abeyance for a period of 2 years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations are found by this Commission.

The suspension shall commence on Monday, January 5, 2026, and terminate on Wednesday, January 7, 2026. The license will be delivered to the Local Licensing Board or its designee on Monday, January 5, 2026, at 9:00 A.M. It will be returned to the licensee on January 8, 2026.

You are advised that pursuant to the provisions of M.G.L. c. 138 § 23, you may petition the Commission to accept an offer in compromise in lieu of suspension within twenty (20) calendar days following such notice of such suspension. If accepted, you may pay a fine using the enclosed form which must be signed by the Licensee and a Massachusetts Licensed Accountant.

You are advised that you have the right to appeal this decision under M.G.L. c. 30A to Superior Court within thirty (30) days upon receipt of this notice.

DECISION

**BSFM CORP D/B/A BRIDGE STREET FOOD MART
407-409 BRIDGE STREET

BSFM Corp d/b/a Bridge Street Food Mart (“Licensee”) holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (“Commission” or “ABCC”) held a hearing on Tuesday, July 29, 2025, regarding an alleged violation of M.G.L. Ch. 138, § 34 Sale or Delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age (3 counts). Prior to the commencement of the hearing the Licensee stipulated to the facts alleged in Investigator Cutter’s Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Violation Report of Investigator A. Cutter;
2. ABCC Licensing Authority Certification, Transfer of License Approved 4/16/2025;
3. Licensee Stipulation of Facts.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On Friday, May 16, 2025, at approximately 4:15 p.m., Investigators Gardner and Cutter (“Investigators”) inspected the business operation of BSFM Corp d/b/a Bridge Street Food Mart (“Licensee” or “Food Mart”).
2. At approximately 7:20 p.m. Investigators observed a pick-up truck enter the parking lot of the licensed premises.
3. Investigators observed one youthful appearing female individual and one youthful appearing male individual exit the truck and enter the establishment. Minutes later the two individuals exited the licensed premises in possession of alcoholic beverages – one 6-pack of Mike’s Hard Lemonade (flavored malt beverage) and one 4-pack of Malibu Splash (flavored malt beverage).

4. Investigators approached the vehicle, identified themselves, and requested proof of age to lawfully purchase and or possess alcoholic beverages. The two individuals who had entered the licensed premises admitted that neither one was 21 years of age.
5. Underage #1, actual date of birth 4/19/2006 (age 19), provided to Investigators a fraudulent Massachusetts driver's license bearing her name with a different birth date, which she stated she used to purchase the alcoholic beverages.
6. Underage #2, actual date of birth 5/09/2006 (age 19), stated to Investigators that he was not asked for any identification when purchasing the alcoholic beverages.
7. At approximately 8:10 p.m. Investigators observed another pick-up truck enter the parking lot of Bridge Street Food Mart.
8. Investigators observed one youthful appearing male individual exit the vehicle and enter the licensed premises. A few minutes later the same individual exited the establishment in possession of one 12-pack of Twisted Tea (flavored malt beverage).
9. Investigators approached the vehicle, identified themselves, and requested proof of age to lawfully purchase and or possess alcoholic beverages. The male who had entered the licensed premises admitted he was not 21 years of age and stated he was in high school.
10. Underage #3, actual date of birth 1/21/2008 (age 17), provided to Investigators a fraudulent Rhode Island driver's license bearing his name with a different birth date, which he stated he used to purchase the alcoholic beverages.
11. Investigators informed the clerk on duty, along with the owner, Tejas Petal, of the above violations and that a report would be submitted to the Chief Investigator for further review.
12. Mr. Patel appeared at the Commission hearing and testified he reviewed the store's surveillance camera and saw the sales take place. He stated he has an identification scanner at the store and a strict policy which seems to be a deterrent to underage individuals.
13. The Licensee has held a license under M.G.L. c. 138, § 15 since April 16, 2025.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the Licensee violated M.G.L. Ch. 138, § 34 Sale or Delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age (3 counts). Therefore, the Commission **SUSPENDS the license for a period of five (5) days, of which three (3) days will be served and two (2) days will be held in abeyance for a period of 2 years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations are found by this Commission.**
