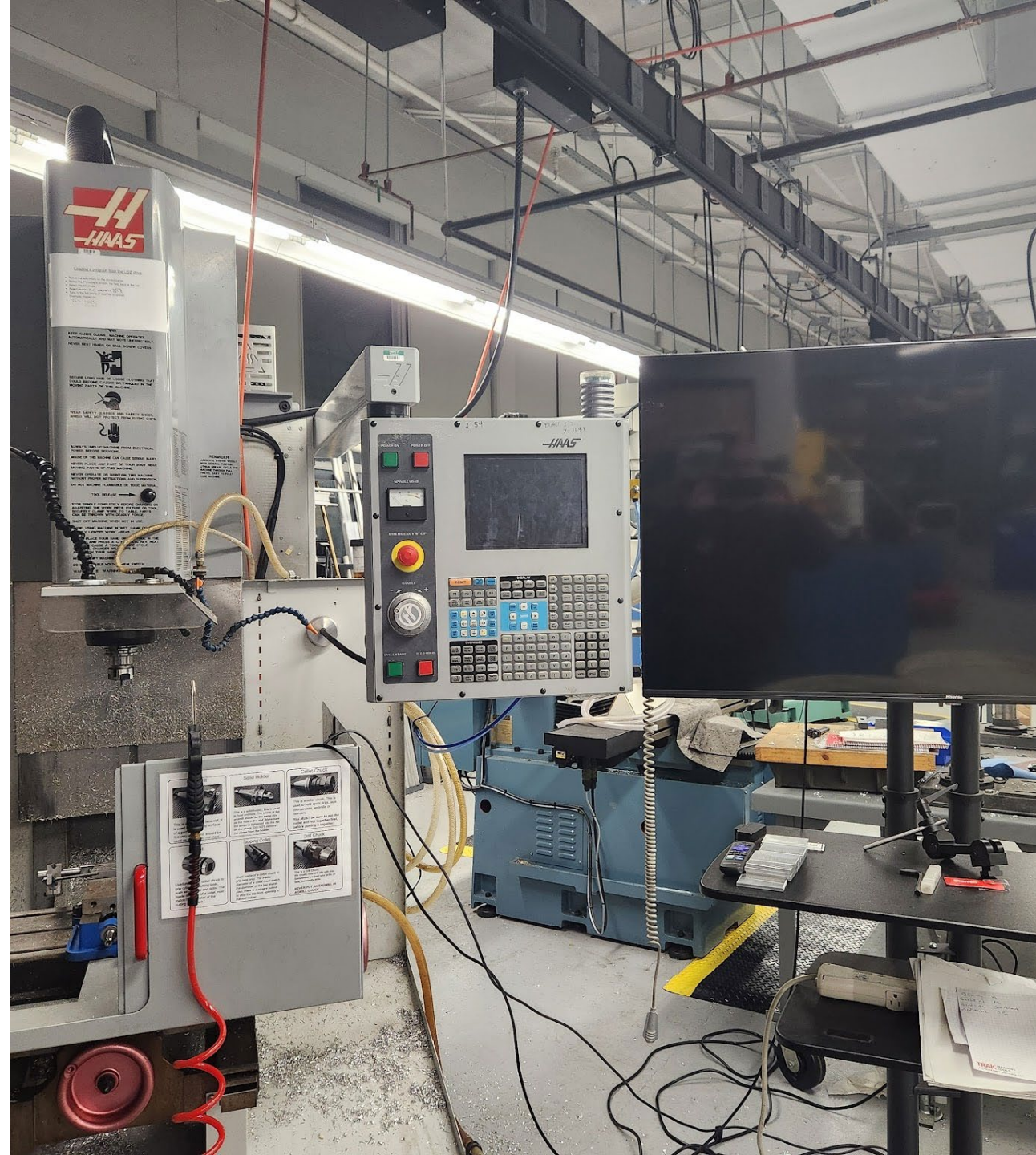
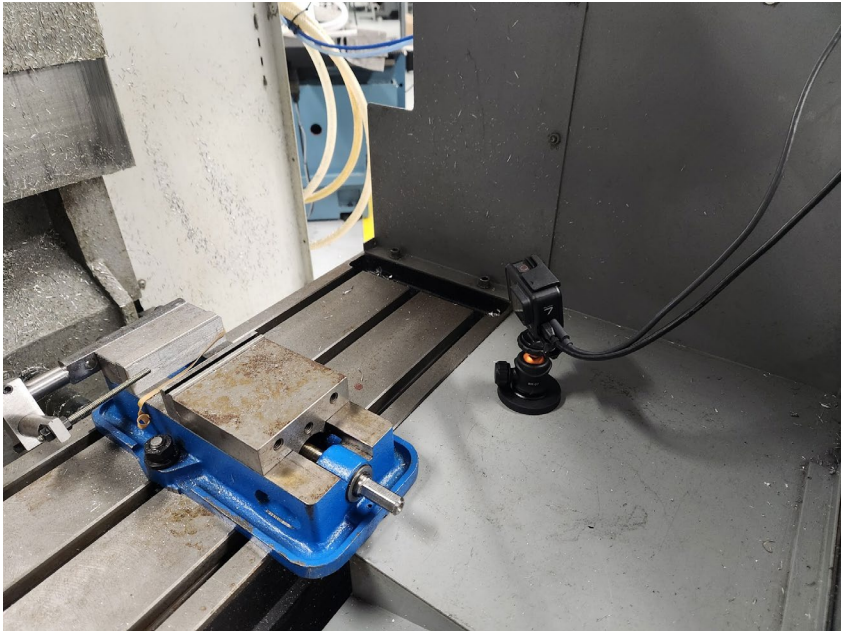
Grade 9- Gopro and monitor added to manual lathe

MCB College Processes

- Student will communicate goal with VRC and complete a statement of vocational objective.
- Student/family must complete a FAFSA. Financial determination is based off of the unmet need.
- MCB can provide OM, AT, books and supply funding, and reader fees.
- Student must maintain above a 2.0 GPA for financial support.
- Part-time attendance must have prior approval.
