TO INTERESTED WHITING FISHING INDUSTRY MEMBERS:

The Massachusetts Division of Marine Fisheries (MA DMF) is seeking members of the whiting fishery interested in participating in a small-mesh experimental fishery in areas of the Gulf of Maine. This work will look to determine if earlier openings of Small Mesh Area 1 and/or the Raised Footrope Exemption areas are suitable for targeting small-mesh species.

At this time, MA DMF is trying to gather a list of interested permit holders for possible participation in an experimental fishery. MA DMF then will invite those pre-qualified to bid on a formal Request for Responses (RFR) for inclusion under a federal Exempted Fishing Permit to conduct this project. Pre-qualification will be limited to those impacted by the recent groundfish disaster given this work is being funded through the Commonwealth's Groundfish Disaster Economic Assistance Program.

At this point, no compensation is planned for participation; however, vessels will be able to keep and land whiting and red hake. MA DMF will provide the required observer coverage at no cost to the vessel.
