Subject:	WIA Youth Chat and Credentials for Youth Tool
Purpose:	 To notify Local Workforce Investment Boards, One-Stop Career Center Operators and other local workforce investment partners of a live WIA Youth Chat, sponsored by the Department of Labor (DOL), Employment and Training Administration's (ETA), Division of Youth Services. The purpose of the chat is to: share what is being done to help youth obtain credentials to learn about what other WIA youth programs are doing around the country and to provide an opportunity to communicate directly with DOL youth staff.
Background:	On Thursday, November 15th at 12:00 – 1:00 EST , Workforce3One will host a WIA Youth Chat on helping youth to attain occupational credentials, how programs can be structured, and what the essential program elements are to help youth attain occupational credentials and move into employment.
