**DECISION**

**FRANCESCA ROSE INC. D/B/A ROUTE 20 BAR & GRILLE  
2341 BOSTON ROAD

Francesca Rose Inc. d/b/a Route 20 Bar & Grille (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission ("Commission" or "ABCC") held a hearing on Tuesday, July 30, 2019, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2)- Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch.138 § 34- Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the Licensee stipulated to the facts alleged in Investigator Watson's Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Investigator Watson's Compliance Check Field Report;
2. Licensee Stipulation of Fact; and
3. Licensee's License Application.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

**FACTS**

1. On Sunday, March 31, 2019, at approximately 4:24 p.m., Investigators Keefe and Watson ("Investigators") investigated the business of Francesca Rose Inc. d/b/a Route 20 Bar & Grille.
2. An underage operative, working with Investigators, purchased from the Licensee an alcoholic beverage, a bottle of Bud Light beer, for three dollars and fifty cents (\$3.50). The underage operative was not asked for identification.
3. The Licensee has held a license under M.G.L. c. 138, § 12 since early 2016 with no previous violations.


### CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the Licensee violated of 204 CMR 2.05 (2)- Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch.138 § 34- Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21). Therefore, the Commission issues a **WARNING**.
