DECISION

MANDARIN WILBRAHAM ENTERPRISE INC. D/B/A MANDARIN WILBRAHAM RESTAURANT 309-B GREAT ROAD

WILBRAHAM, MA 01095 LICENSE#: 1472-00045

Mandarin Wilbraham Enterprise Inc. d/b/a Mandarin Wilbraham Restaurant (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, July 25, 2017, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) – Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, §34 – Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the Licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Di Cicco's Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

- 1. Investigator Di Cicco's Compliance Check Field Report; and
- 2. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts.
- A. E-Tips Certificate for Bartender A.S.; and
- B. E-Tips Certificate for Licensee/Owner Z.G.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

The Commission took Administrative Notice of the Licensee's record.

FACTS

- 1. On Monday, May 15, 2017, at approximately 5:56 p.m., Investigators Keefe and Di Cicco ("Investigators") investigated the business operation of Mandarin Wilbraham Enterprise Inc. d/b/a Mandarin Wilbraham Restaurant.
- 2. An underage operative, working with Investigators, was in possession of an alcoholic beverage, a Bud Light beer. The underage operative was not asked for identification.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence the Commission finds the Licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) - Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, §34 – Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. As the Licensee has been in business for more than 10 years with no prior violations, the Commission issues a **WARNING**.
