

## TWO WEEK LOOK-AHEAD

**January 2, 2018 – January 14, 2018**

The following work items are ongoing along Winthrop Shore Drive. You can expect to see these activities continue over the next two weeks.

The work is wrapping up for the winter, and may include:

- Minor work on the sidewalks
- Seawall repairs in the Highlands area between Locust Street and Grovers Avenue:
  - **This work is tidally dependent, so work hours will vary to coincide with favorable tidal conditions**
  - The construction work areas will be closed off for the safety of the public.
- Electrical work, including the installation of light poles
- Continued cleanup of roadway materials

**Please note that some of the current work activities on the project will require construction work on Saturdays. Winter shutdown will be beginning and all roadway work will be complete until the spring. During this time, the residential sidewalk on the west side of Winthrop Shore Drive will remain open. There will continue to be minor work in areas that don't affect the roadway.**

### Traffic and Parking Impacts

- Parking will be re-opened during the winter shutdown.
