

TWO WEEK LOOK-AHEAD

The following work items are ongoing along Winthrop Shore Drive. You can expect to see these activities continue over the next two weeks.

- Roadway construction will continue with excavation and grading from Mermaid Ave. to the north.
- Paving is planned for Tuesday and Wednesday the 17th and 18th (weather permitting).
- Curbing installation on the ocean side will also continue advance to the north.
- Detours and setups will be in place during working hours.
- Police on site to help manage traffic.
- Work hours:
 - 6 am – 7 am for setups and detours
 - 7 am - 3:30 pm for construction and
 - 3:30 pm - 4:30 pm for safety breakdown of setups and any patching or a need to make the roadway safe for the travelling public during the down time.
